

Friday night football back at CMH Field

The high school football season unofficially kicked off Friday, as teams from Astoria, Seaside, Warrenton, Knappa and Ilwaco all took part in jamboree scrimmages.

The Fishermen hosted three junior varsity teams and nine varsity squads for a seven-hour jamboree at Columbia Memorial Field.

Teams from Clatskanie, Estacada, Ilwaco, Seaside, Stayton, Tillamook, Warrenton and Yamhill-Carlton took part, while Knappa played in a four-team jamboree at Nestucca.

“Overall, I thought we did a lot more positive things than negative — it was a pretty good night,” said Astoria coach Howard Rub. “We came out healthy, and that’s the No. 1 thing in a jamboree.

“Stayton is a much improved team, as is Estacada,” he said. “I think all the teams there got something out of it.”

Individually, Rub said, “Carter Wallace ran the ball hard, and I was really pleased with his play at linebacker. He’s played on the edge more in the past, but he did a nice job of filling in for Clay Englund (currently out with a nonfootball related injury).”

Rub added, “I like how some of the players new to the program played,” including Ryan Palek (played at Knappa two years ago), Tristen Osborne (Modoc, Calif.) and Samboy Tuimato (Tillamook).

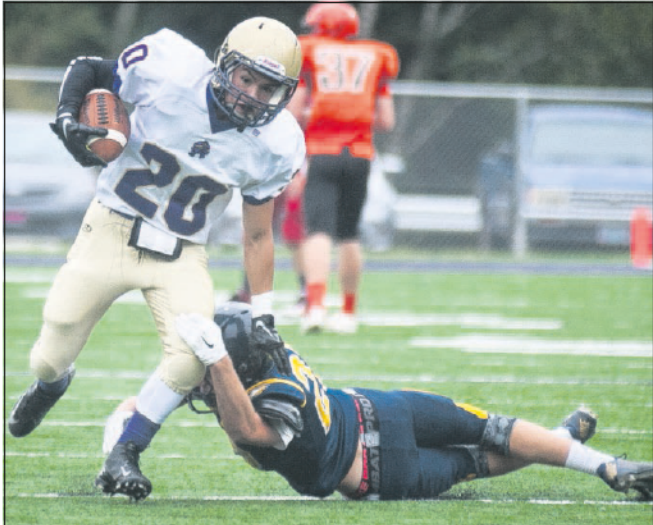
“They all played well, considering it’s their first year in a new program, and they’re still learning the terminology,” Rub said.

Ryker Helmersen and Kyle Strange also made big plays on both sides of the ball for the Fishermen, who officially open the season Friday at home vs. Taft.
