

Harber throwing strikes for Helena

Astoria's Conor Harber started his third game of the season on the mound last Saturday for the Helena (Mont.) Brewers, the Pioneer League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

And the former Fisherman responded with another solid effort, allowing just one hit over three innings, with four strikeouts and three walks in a 9-0, one-hit win over Billings.

In his first month at the professional level, Harber has appeared in eight games, and has a

The Northwest Christian

University volleyball team won its seventh straight match to open the season, a four-game set (13-25, 25-20, 25-20, 27-25) over George Fox in Newberg Tuesday night.

Contributing to the victory was Seaside's Danielle Willyard, a freshman with the Beacons, along with sister Kelly Willyard.

Danielle Willyard had three blocks while hitting a team-best .294 in Tuesday's win.

The 7-0 start is the best in NCU school history. The previous best record after seven

matches was 5-2. Tuesday's win was also the first over George Fox in NCU school history.

The Beacons look to ride their momentum into the conference season, when they hit the road for Klamath Falls Friday. NCU will open with Oregon Tech (5-1) before traveling to face No. 16 Southern Oregon (7-0) Saturday.

Other former Gulls continuing their athletic careers at Northwest Christian include soccer players Hannah Garhofer, Aaron Chesnut and Ian Hawksford.

Scott Lee, the chairman of the Board of Commissioners, praised Mays as a "great choice."

Mays was the city manager in Cannon Beach for more than eight years before retiring in July 2014. He was previously the city administrator in Jefferson City, Mo., and the city manager in Collinsville and Sterling, Ill.

Commissioners are expected to choose a consulting firm to help with the search for a new chief executive. The county has had nine county managers in 15 years.

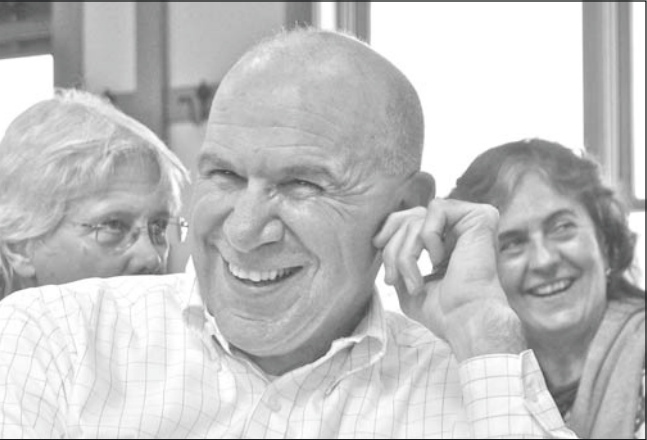
Several department directors have also left over the

past few years, turnover that has led to questions about the county's ability to attract and retain high-level managers.

Elizabeth Lawless, who was hired in July after a nationwide search to replace Dean Perez as the county's human resources manager, was supposed to start work Monday but backed out.

Lawless, a University of Oregon graduate, was a human resources director in Kansas.

Somers said he hopes to have an interim human resources manager by next week. Mays — or the new county manager — will oversee the search for a human resources manager.

With the return of gunfire and fires, the council is returning to the advertised rates of \$20 per carload, plus the \$5 day-use fee; the bicycle gate price is \$5 per person, 12 and older, with a \$15 per family maximum.

The camps open 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday through Monday at the Fort Stevens Historic Area. They include battles at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. Saturday

and Sunday; a battle at noon Monday; artillery demonstrations at noon Saturday and Sunday; and a speed-loading contest at 1 p.m. Sunday. In addition to mock battles, the council demonstrates cavalry, medicine and music on the battlefield Saturday and Sunday. They host fashion shows, parades, bands, camp presentations and an Abraham Lincoln impersonator.

Better, wetter weather

Recent rains and cooler weather has prompted the Clatsop County Fire Defense Board to lift the ban on campfires and burn barrels as of Thursday. Home campfires and burn barrels still require a burn permit from the Oregon Department of Forestry or local fire departments. Burn barrels are only allowed until 10 a.m. daily. No open debris burning is allowed at this time.

Campfires are only allowed in designated campgrounds. Campers should use the campfire ring and make sure the campfire is cool to the touch before leaving the site. Driving in the forest requires a tool and either 1 gallon of water or a 2 1/2-pound fire extinguisher. Call the forest landowner for information regarding access. Confirm that campfires are allowed at your location.
