

Regis wins the rematch with Knappa, 7-6

STAYTON — Nearly one year after Knappa scored a season-opening 6-0 win over Regis, the Rams returned the favor Friday night with a 7-6 victory over the Loggers, ranked No. 3 in the preseason coaches poll.

Both touchdowns came in the second quarter, with Knappa scoring first on a 5-yard run by Andrew Goozee. The Loggers failed on the two-point conversion.

Regis answered with a 23-yard pass from Bryce Piete to Austin Moore, and the Rams kicked the extra point to take the lead.

The Loggers had the best scoring opportunity of the second half, as they had a first-and-goal at the 9-yard line with just under two minutes remaining in the game.

Knappa was unable to score however, as the Rams made a goal line stand to end the game.

Goozee rushed for 189 yards on 46 carries.

Dakota Severson, Braedon Eltagonde and Ethan Rubus had interceptions for Knappa.

Sears: Store specializes in appliances, home, garden supplies

“For 11 years, we’ve preached buy local,” he said. “To have a local couple take over I think is great.”

The store has been successful, he said, since Sears Hometown Stores split off from the main Sears company about three years ago. The hometown spinoff includes about 1,300 locations in less-populated areas nationwide, farther away from larger Sears locations.

While there’s a certain amount of loyalty for the hometown stores, Jim Montgomery said, success still largely depends on having the latest items at a competitive price. And the Sears store hangs its hat on customer service, he said, providing superior repair services and display sales larger stores often don’t do. The store specializes in appliances, home, garden and Craftsman tools.

The big move is to the box stores in Warrenton, Fried said, but there are a lot of people loyal to the couple’s hometown store.

“We hope to maintain a lot and not have a changing of the guard,” Dyal said. “It’s cool being in the downtown. The people you see walking down the street, they’re your customers.”

The people walking behind Sears on the Astoria Riverwalk often see the signs of old companies that came before, such as the Mason-Ehrman & Co. sign on the back of Sears, which has moved around downtown from a Flavel building, through the current Bikes and Beyond and into its current location. Dyal and Fried said they would like to eventually refurbish the Mason-Ehrman & Co. sign, giving passers-by a view into the history of the building.

Rick Fried and Thea Dyal took ownership of the Astoria Sears Hometown Store in downtown last month. They hope to eventually refurbish the murals on the back of the Mason-Ehrman & Co. building that houses the store.
