

That was in Newport a year later when Mohava Niemi offered space for a second, more imposing pub. Remember Mohava? She was the legendary founder of Mo's restaurants. She had always wanted to live over a bar, and so she did, until her death in 1992. A picture of Mo still hangs in the Newport pub, as was her wish. She's nude in her bathtub.

The Rogue revolution is a small revolution. It's not political, and it's all about handcrafted ales, porters, stouts, and lagers. These rogues, however, have established a sort of nation within a nation. The "Rogue Nation," with its own "Declaration of Interdependence," which states, in part: "With tongues firmly planted in our cheeks and with the inherent power derived from within and the Laws of Hops and Barley (we) declare the intent to form a Micro-Nation." This nation claims to be founded on hard work and a penchant for taking the long shot.

That first basement brewery has, in truth, expanded mightily. Rogue now crafts spirits and soft drinks, as well as ales, and grow their own grain, hops, and fruit on several Oregon farms. It's something Rogue calls "dirtoir" (instead of the tonier "terroir" of wine): the soil and climate that creates the hops and grain that make the ales special.

You can join the revolution by driving over the rickety-looking Pier 39 entrance (or take the trolley and walk the last few yards) to the local outpost of this beer revolution, where you'll find a large pub in an old cannery building.

Rogue makes scores of beers, many of them seasonal, but you can count on a hearty selection. Their signature Dead Guy Ale is a must try. Rogue also has a way with chocolate; the Chocolate Stout and Mocha Porter are both exceptional. Other favorites: Brutal Bitter, Hazelnut Brown Nectar, Pendleton Pilsner and the Rogue Farms 8 Hop IPA. If you're in the mood for something more unusual, you may find the Sriracha HOT Stout (the bottled version comes in a red bottle with the rooster on it) to your liking. Or the Voodoo Doughnut Bacon Maple Ale, or perhaps the XS Old Crustacean Barleywine.

At Rogue.com you'll find a link to the Rogue Nation. There you can read the Declaration of Interdependence and apply for citizenship. Better yet, stroll out to Pier 39, visit the Bumble Bee Cannery Museum, ogle the old boats, and order beer at the Rogue.

It's the tastiest revolution you'll ever join.

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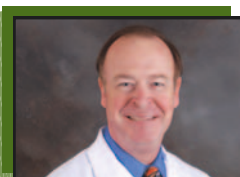
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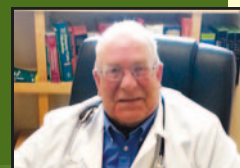
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
