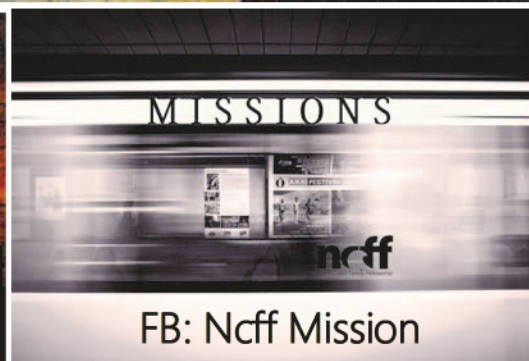
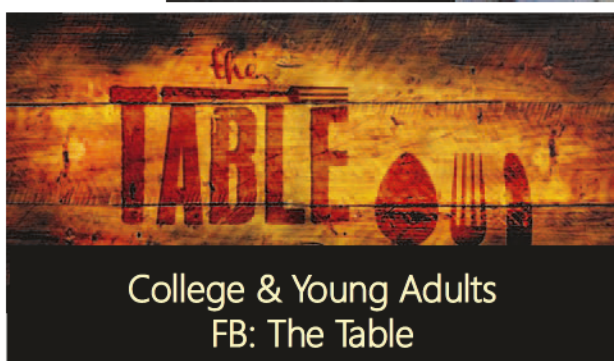
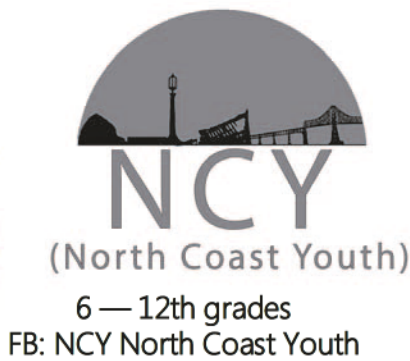
Starting on October 4th The River will begin meeting at Clatsop Community College!
