## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Liberty Theater has been lovingly restored and currently operates as a performing arts center, concert hall, conference center and elegant event venue.

Liberty Theater, located in the heart of downtown Astoria, was designed to transport you to a Venetian Palace and is one of Oregon's best examples of a 1920s vaudeville-motion picture palace. Opened in 1925, the theater was originally home to vaudeville acts and silent movies.

Recognized by the National Trust for Historic Preservation-Save America's Treasures, the Liberty was chosen Best Historic Venue in Oregon "People's Choice" by Northwest Meeting + Events, 2013 and is a winner of the Dr. Edward Harvey "This Place Matters" Historic Preservation Award, City of Astoria
