# **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

We learned early on that many of our children and students were dealing with poverty to the extent that it was becoming a barrier to learning. Issues beyond academics and beyond the school environment were affecting our children and their ability to learn. Our children were going to school hungry. Many didn't even have basic clothing such as shoes that fit; or warm jackets. Their mental and emotional well-being was tenuous and so fragile. So we began to slowly identify issues that we could impact and hopefully make a difference in. Issues such as lack of parental involvement or engagement; parental alcohol and substance abuse, unemployment, housing issues were a few that were identified. Abuse accounts for a great deal of our children's mental and behavioral needs. These had a direct impact on student attendance, participation and achievement. The need to surround our children/students with more than school books became very apparent the more we learned about this issue. We immediately created the weekend backpack program and started a monthly Healthy Hygiene backpack that is full of items such as toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo etc. Our commitment is that 100% of all dollars received will be used for projects.
