

This design-build project involved remodeling the historic 4,600-square-feet Finnish Meat Market into a coffee roasting facility and coffee house. This project received the Dr. Edward Harvey Historical Preservation Award.

The Astoria Trolley Barn is a unique steel building structure. It contains numerous small windows and a pop-up roof area that are a challenge to fabricate with post and beam construction and a metal skin. The City of Astoria felt the design of the structure needed to be historically conscious and reflect the use as barn for the Old Trolley is houses.

We worked extensively with the City of Astoria, the engineer and PHI Construction to provide a building that had the appearance required and would withstand the strong storms and weather that are typical of the Port of Astoria location. Also, a mechanical pit was required in the floor, which was a challenge due to the low elevation and high ground water at high tide.
