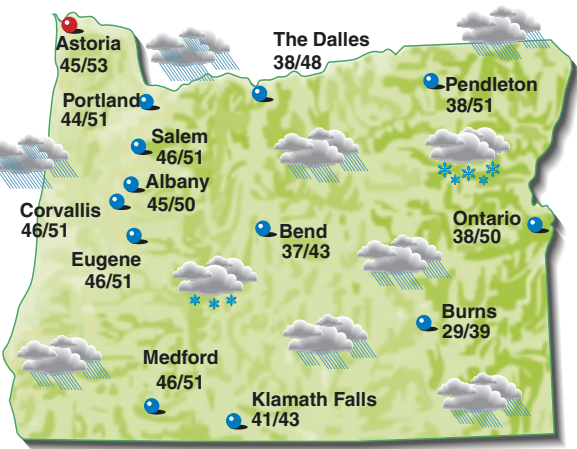

Tonight's Sky: The Milky Way arches from the Northern Cross to W-shaped Cassiopeia high overhead, to near the face of Taurus.

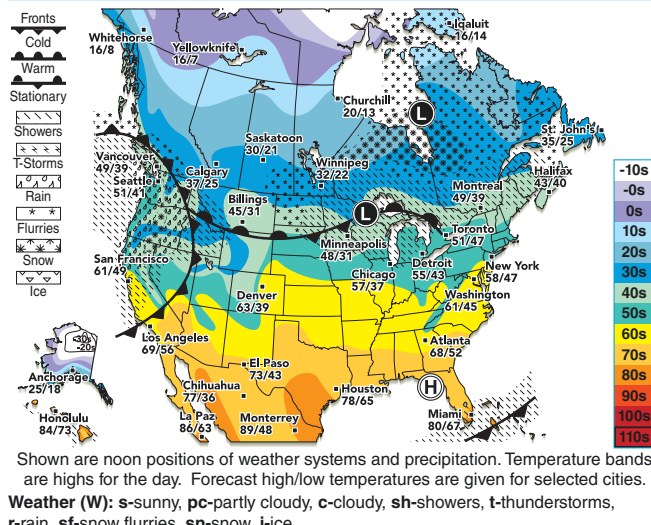
