My life is worthless." He claimed he had no food left, but refused to let me bring over groceries. He said he didn't care if he wasted away, although he promised not to kill himself.

Over the weekend, I texted him, but there was no response. By Monday, I was frantic. I reached out to his physician, leaving a message with the assistant, emphatically stating that my son promised he would not harm himself. He just didn't want to eat. I told the assistant that it was crucial that I speak with the doctor before an intervention. Well, this inept nitwit conveved the wrong information to the doctor, resulting in a call from the police inquiring about a welfare check. And instead of talking to me, the doctor phoned my parents.



Then Edgar called, ranting that I have totally messed up his life because I told his doctor he was suicidal. I phoned the doctor, who apologized profusely for the confusion her assistant had caused and assured me that she would call my son and straighten things out. I waited another day and then sent Edgar a text, wanting to open communications. He replied, "Forget it, the damage is already done. I can't go back to that doctor." He said he was going to move far away where no one could find him. What do I do? — *Drama* 

Dear Drama: You need to give Edgar some breathing room. Although he may actually be grateful that you care, this much attention to his mental health might be overwhelming him. Send a calm text, saying you love him, you're sorry you upset him, and that you hope he will get back in touch soon.
