

# Jewell basketball on a roll in season openers

The Jewell girls basketball team has opened the season with a 2-0 record, following two decisive wins in three days.

Jewell tipped off the season last Saturday with a 39-4 nonleague victory over Eddyville, followed by a 34-10 win Monday over Oregon School for the Deaf.

Gabi Morales scored a game-high 12 points in the latest victory, with six rebounds. Teammate Sophia Olvera had four points and seven boards, and Ashley Thurston finished with four points and four steals.

Jewell held OSD scoreless in the second quarter and led 19-2 at halftime, and 30-4 after three quarters.

In the opener vs. Eddyville, Morales scored 11 points, with seven rebounds and four steals.

##### Jays defeat Eddyville, OSD

Tuesday's Casco League Perrydale at Jewell boys basketball game was postponed and will be played at a later date.

The Blue Jays will take a 2-1 record into tonight's game at Crosshill Christian, as they

followed a season-opening 45-25 loss at Open Door Academy with consecutive wins over Eddyville (25-21) and Oregon School for the Deaf (34-25).

In the victory over Eddyville, Jewell overcame an early deficit by outscoring the Eagles 16-4 in the second quarter, and 2-0 in the third period.

Jewell scored just four points in the second half, but held on for the win.

Trystan Silva had 14 points, eight rebounds and four steals, and teammate Ben Stahly added 11 rebounds and three blocked shots. Thomas Meehan had nine boards.

In Monday's win over OSD, Jewell went on a 7-2 run in the third period for a 25-18 lead.

Silva led the Jays with 13 points, while Stahly scored nine with 10 rebounds. Silva also had six steals, five rebounds and three blocks.
