SCAPPOOSE BIG WINNER IN 3-WAY DUAL

The Astoria wrestling team hosted a three-way dual meet Wednesday night at the Brick House, as wrestlers from Scappoose and Seaside joined the Fishermen for a night of Cowapa League wrestling.

Scappoose was the big winner, as the Indians scored victories over Astoria (47-33) and Seaside (69-9), while the Fishermen defeated the Gulls in the Clatsop Clash portion of the meet, 54-18.
