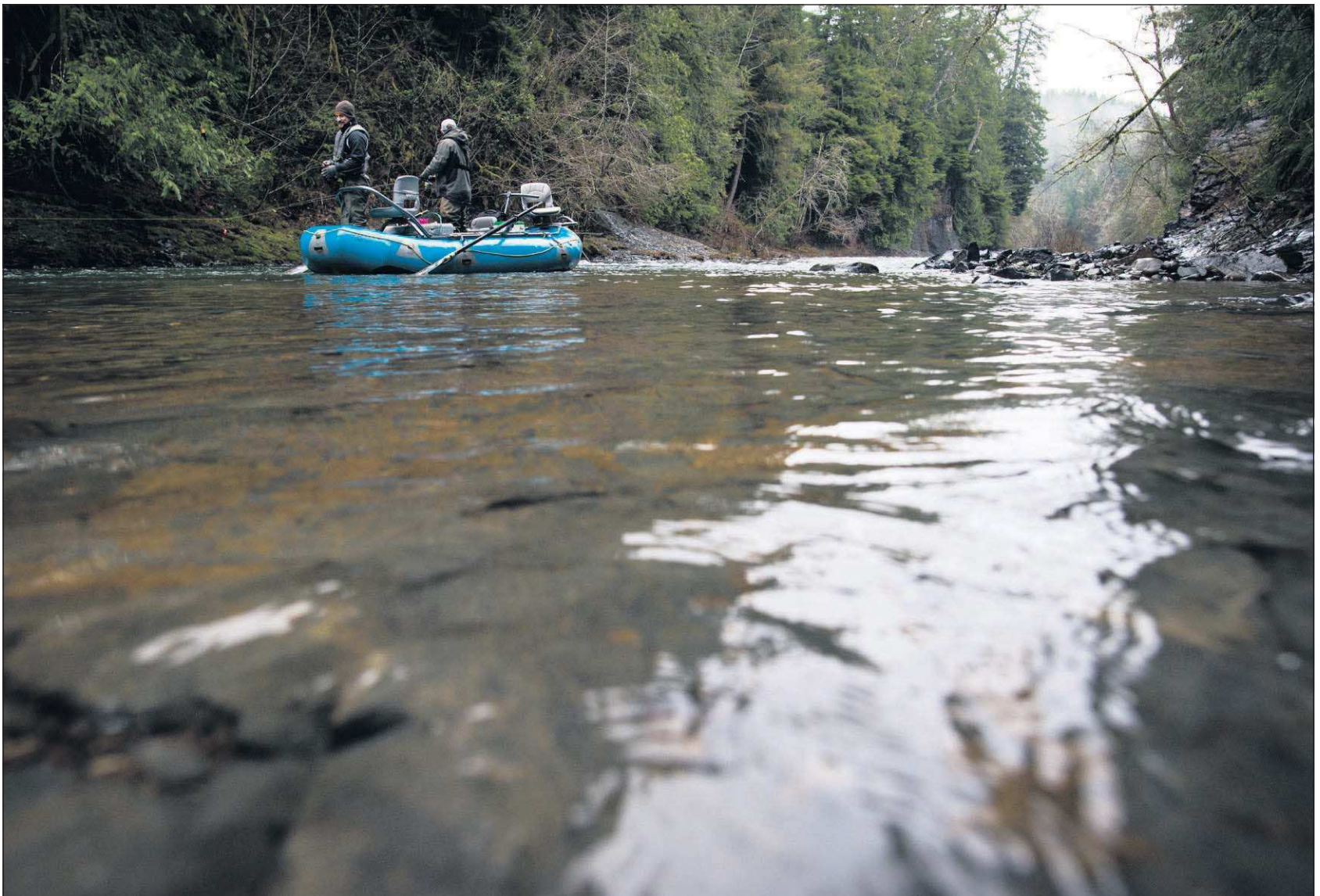




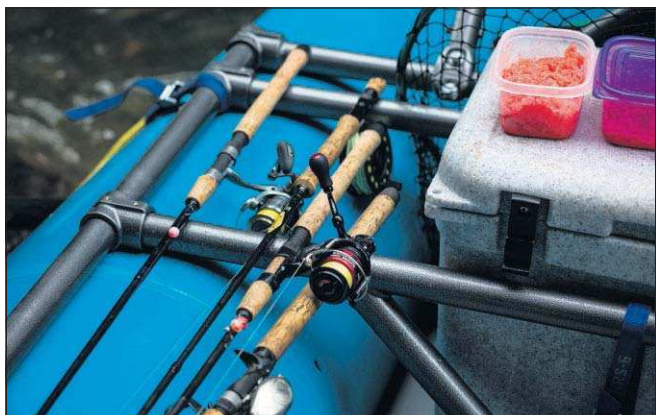

Fishing guide Drake Radditz baits a hook with cured steelhead eggs.



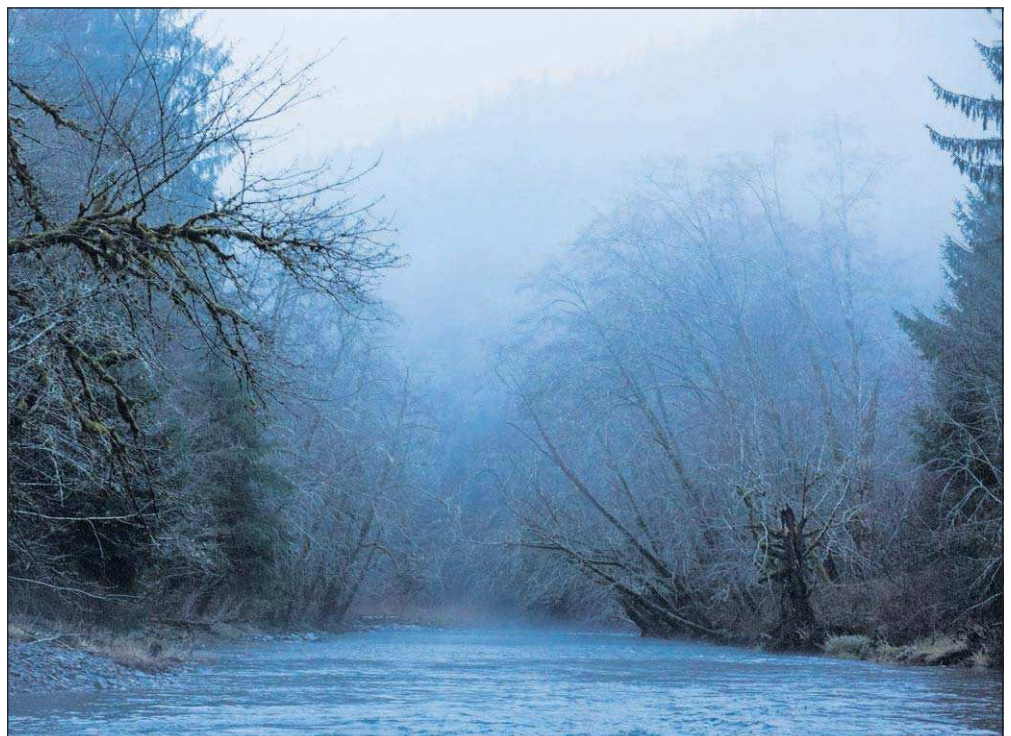
A steelhead leaps out of the water after being hooked by Tim Trainor during a fishing trip on the North Fork Nehalem River.



Tim Trainor and guide Drake Radditz cast out their lines from the raft while fishing along the North Fork Nehalem River.



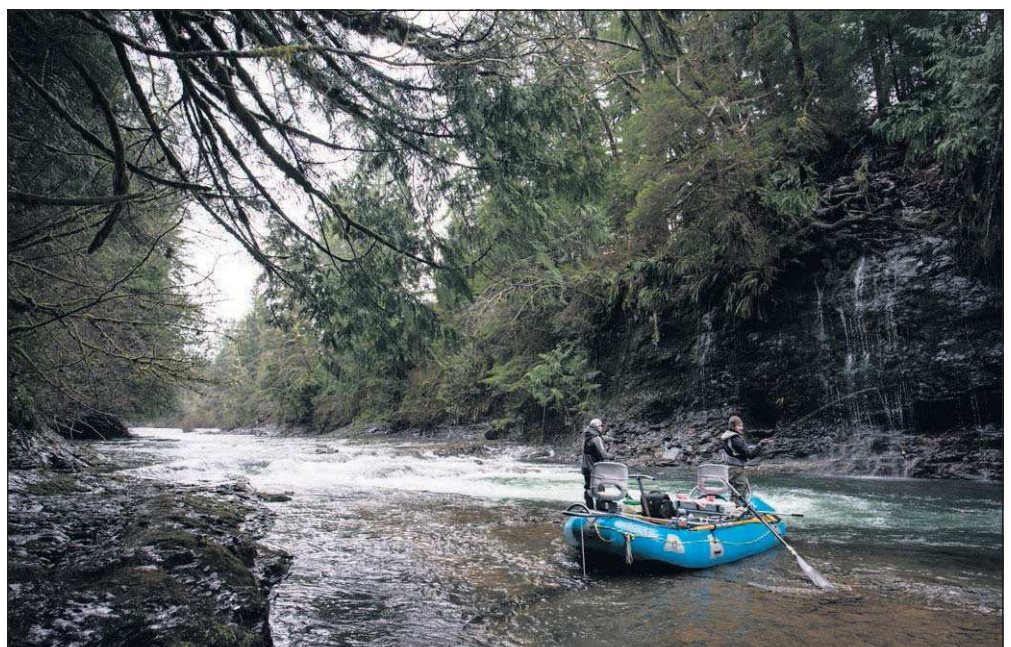
