Seaside Scholarships Inc. is managing a new scholarship, created in memory of local resident Wendy Richardson, who died in December 2015.

The Wendy Richardson Memorial Scholarship is the

brainchild of several women who knew her and whose sons participated in sports with Richardson's son, Nick, now 19. The Seaside Scholarships board agreed to manage the memorial scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student based on excellent community service, a characteristic associated with

Richardson, according to board member Sally LaCoste.

"That is how everyone thinks of Wendy: how involved she was in the community," LaCoste said.

Seaside Scholarships is a nonprofit organization that raises money used for its own achievement scholarships and also manages numerous memorial and other scholarships for local businesses and individuals. The objective is to make it easy for Seaside High School seniors

to submit a single application that will be considered for all qualifying scholarships.

The Wendy Richardson Memorial Scholarship will be awarded starting with the class of 2016.
