

Ilwaco wrestlers take the Beach Brawl

ILWACO, Wash. — The Ilwaco wrestling team won a day of “brawling” Saturday, as the Fishermen came out of their annual tournament with a first-place showing in the team standings.

Ilwaco hosted the famous “Beach Brawl” tournament, where the home team won all three of its championship matches to finish with 164 points, ahead of Castle Rock (117), Adna (108) and North Eugene (103).

Astoria placed seventh out of 18 schools with 88 points, while Warrenton was 10th, Knappa 13th and Seaside 17th.

Ilwaco wrestlers Jack Kaino (152), Daylin Kenner (160) and Alec Bell (195) all won individual titles, while teammates Trenton Cox (106), Brandon Sparks (170) and DeAntay Kellogg all took third.

“Ilwaco and (head coach) Kevin McNulty put on a great tournament, running five mats most of the day,” Knappa coach Dan Owings said.

The Loggers “had our usual wrestlers getting in some of the medals,” he said.

Andrew Goozee took first at 182 pounds, winning all three of his matches by pin, including an opening round fall in 16 seconds over Alex Palermo of Tenino-Winlock, and a 2:16 pin over Clatskanie’s Brenden Hicks.

Goozee won his title match bout in 44 seconds.

Luke Goozee placed second at 113, and Reuben Cruz took third at 160.

JEWELL — The Jewell girls basketball team played the final 2 minutes and 23 seconds with just four players on the floor, and still defeated Willamette Valley Christian Monday night, 36-34 in a Casco League game at Jewell.


