

Arch Cape: 'The county makes the final decision'

is typically completed "over the counter" for other Clatsop County residents and developers.

"The bottom line is the county makes the final decision, so to have a two-step process and two-step review process is really not necessary," Giguere said.

During public comment Wednesday, some South County residents spoke in support of keeping the committee, or at least streamlining its role in the county. The residents called it an important community resource and a group that knows its community.

John Mersereau, a former committee member, said he recalls when the group formed more than 30 years ago. Its intent was to have neighbors closely involved with new developments.

For years, he said, it worked well.

"People were able to talk over differences. Sometimes there were changes made, sometimes there weren't," Mersereau said. "It was a face-to-face meeting with neighbors to hash out some differences. That had value to me."

After disbanding the committee, the Clatsop commissioners offered an alternative for Arch Cape area residents. The board agreed to begin formally recognizing neighborhood associations.

The associations would be able to comment on land use matters, but would have no review or approval authority themselves.

Commission Chairman Scott Lee said the associations could form in all corners of unincorporated Clatsop County, not just the Arch Cape area. Potential locations include Clatsop Plains, Elsie-Jewell, Lewis and Clark/Olney-Walluski and rural Seaside.

"A neighborhood association will do more to bring the community together and affect the needs of Arch Cape," Lee said.

In other business:

- The Board of Commissioners approved the employment contract for new County Manager Cameron Moore. The former chief executive officer for the Champaign County, Illinois, Regional Planning Commission will join the county April 6. His starting salary will be \$150,000 annually.

Warriors: Public comments welcome during district's next two board meetings

Removing the Native American imagery — gym pads at the grade school, carpet sections, other pieces of artwork and stickers on helmets — would be a minimal cost, he said, while the most difficult situation would be figuring out what to do with the purple statue in front of the high school, fused together with 1,000 smaller metal warriors made by students in the 1970s.

"One thing I want to be clear on is that it's also my recommendation we incorporate more local Native American culture in our area," Jeffery said, noting the mascots in the district

bear more resemblance to Mohawk and Great Plains tribes.

In 2007, the district had a cartoonish Native American caricature in the high school gymnasium replaced with a mural of Clatsop-Nehalem tribal members rowing a canoe on the Columbia River. Regardless of the mascot, Jeffery said, the district should work with local tribes to get more culturally relevant curriculum into its schools.

Jeffery said he will have the district's administrators develop non-native imagery for the Warriors, while recommending the district invite public comment over the next two board meetings March 8 and April 12.

Fallen police officer remembered in Cannon Beach as co-worker, friend

CANNON BEACH — Before the memorial for fallen Seaside police Sgt. Jason Gooding on Friday, American Legion Post 168 in Cannon Beach will join the Seaside American Legion, police departments and other members of the law enforcement community in a procession that will wind through Seaside streets.

"A comrade in uniform has fallen in the line of duty," Cannon Beach Post Commander Dan O'Reilly said. "He heroically performed his sworn oath until the end. His sacrifice must never be forgotten."

O'Reilly's son, Michael, a police commander in Kent, Washington, will attend the service representing the Kent Police Department.

"It takes your breath away," he said of the shooting. "This really hits close to me."

When Gooding joined the Seaside Police Department, he was one of the first recruits to train under Jason Schermerhorn, who was then a corporal officer with the department. The two men met soon after Gooding moved to town, and their wives became fast friends.

Schermerhorn, now the Cannon Beach police chief, worked with Gooding all 13 years, 10 of those years in the Seaside Police Department.

Gooding was shot and killed by a suspect wanted on a felony warrant.

Schermerhorn was one of the Cannon Beach officers who responded to the scene of the Friday shooting.

"It's certainly a huge loss for the law enforcement community, and for all of our families," he said. "He was a big family man. He was a great volunteer for his daughters and other girls with basketball."

Gooding's family, friends and colleagues could always rely on him, Schermerhorn said. "And he just had a great sense of humor," he added.

Bruce's Candy Kitchen locations in Cannon Beach and Seaside are both donating to the Gooding family. Seaside Outlets has agreed to match up to

\$5,000 of the donations that Bruce's gets, co-owner Brian Taylor said.

Taylor, co-owner and production manager at Bruce's, was close with Gooding as a friend and fellow coach.

"I'm very grateful to have known him," Taylor said. "We're grateful for the community that's here. It's a good tribute for Jason. We want to spread the love and take care of the girls. This is a chance for people who don't know them but want to help."

Many others took to the Cannon Beach Police Department Facebook page to express their condolences and

prayers for the family.

Megan Morris, of Warrenton, works at Columbia Bank in Cannon Beach and had close family ties with Gooding, who was her father's friend. Gooding's daughter was her sister's friend.

"I heard about it before it was public through friends," Morris said. "I was obviously shocked and heartbroken."

On Saturday, she began a fundraiser for the family on the website GoFundMe. The page raised \$10,000 in three days, with contributions from more than 150 people. Donations were given to the Oregon Fallen Badge Foundation,

which is accepting donations to support the Gooding family on its website and at U.S. Bank locations.

"It's very hard for me to keep any emotion out of it," Post Commander O'Reilly said. "It's so close to our military experiences. We consider police brothers and sisters in uniform."

The Cannon Beach Chamber of Commerce is looking at ways to help out the Gooding family. "We want to do whatever we can to encourage people to assist and donate to the Oregon Fallen Badge Foundation," said Executive Director Court Carrier.
