

Brown names Saiki director of troubled DHS

State agency undergoing outside review

SALEM — Gov. Kate Brown appointed longtime civil servant Clyde Saiki as director of the troubled Oregon Department of Human Services on Tuesday.

Saiki has served as the agency's interim director since early November, when Brown demoted acting DHS director Jerry Waybrant. Brown made the change after Willamette Week reported that top officials at the agency, including Waybrant and former director Erinn Kelley-Siel, knew for more than a year about alleged child neglect and financial problems at the Portland foster care agency Give Us This Day, yet did nothing. Kelley-Siel had resigned in July.

Additional emails released by the state later showed top DHS officials knew as far back as 2009 that Give Us This Day was operating without a state license and was staffed entirely by people with criminal records, the EO Media Group/Pamplin Media Group Capital Bureau reported. Give Us This Day closed in September under a settlement agreement with the Oregon Department of Justice.

Brown said on Tuesday that Saiki had already made progress since taking the helm at Human Services.

"Clyde has been instrumental as the interim director in increasing accountability at the agency, particularly regarding the safety of young people in foster care, and coordinating an independent review of DHS programs to determine improvements needed to ensure youth are served and protected," Brown said in a press release Tuesday. "His leadership has already made a difference at the agency, and he has my full support in continuing to make the changes we expect at DHS."

Saiki's appointment is sub-

ject to confirmation by the state Senate, which could occur during interim legislative meetings in May.

Brown ordered a review of the agency by an outside contractor, and a Human Services spokesman said on Tuesday the review is still underway.

State Sen. Sara Gelsler, D-Corvallis, has criticized DHS' failure to protect children and other vulnerable Oregonians in the agency's care. Gelsler sponsored legislation which lawmakers passed earlier this month, to tighten DHS licensing standards and mandate that the agency take action when children are at risk. Gelsler hailed Saiki's appointment as DHS director and said he has been willing to tackle the problems in an "open and candid way."

"Clyde has just been great," Gelsler said on Tuesday. "We're really lucky he agreed to stay. The changes I'm seeing are swift and strong and appropriate."

Saiki's appointment creates a vacancy at the state's Department of Administrative Services, where he was the director and state's chief operating officer. George Naughton, the state's chief financial officer and budget director, has been filling in as that agency's director and chief operating officer in recent months.

Saiki was a deputy director at the Oregon Department of Transportation, before Brown appointed him as chief operating officer last year. Saiki also previously worked 23 years at Human Services, and he told the Statesman Journal in November that he heard of problems at Give Us This Day during his tenure at the agency. "We had heard about that, but they had been investigated and we had continued to license them at that point in time. It wasn't the issue that it is now," Saiki said, according to the newspaper.

Salmon: Warm ocean water had a negative effect on last year's runs

"We are hard-working people, and we want to try within the conservation concerns to get a season," he said. "This is just the beginning of the process. That's one thing we want to keep in mind. We're nowhere close to the end."

The Pacific Fishery Management Council sets ocean fishing seasons off the Pacific coast. The chinook and coho quotas approved by the council will be part of a salmon fishing package that includes marine and freshwater fisheries throughout Puget Sound, the Columbia River and Washington's coastal areas. State and tribal co-managers are considering options for those fisheries, which will be finalized at the council's April meeting in Vancouver, Washington.

Washington Fish and Wildlife Department spokesman Kyle Adicks said coho salmon returns to the Columbia River are the main driver of ocean fisheries off the Washington coast, and the predictions for returns this year are about half of last year's forecast.

The state also has "really weak forecasts" for coastal coho and Puget Sound stocks, he said, and managers want to make sure they're protected from ocean salmon fisheries.

Adicks said warm water in the ocean had a negative effect on last year's salmon runs, "and those conditions persisted, so we're expecting to see a similar weak return this year."

However, managers are expecting a strong return of Columbia River fall chinook salmon is expected back this year, including lower river hatchery fish, which have been the backbone of the recreational ocean chinook fishery. In a news release, Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Director Jim Unsworth said he hopes fishery man-

agers can provide some ocean salmon fishing opportunities this year, but they need to protect the diminished number of wild coho expected to return this year.

"Fishery managers face many difficult decisions in the weeks ahead as we move toward solidifying salmon-fishing seasons for the state," Unsworth said. "We know that severely limiting opportunities will hurt many families and communities that depend on these fisheries. But conserving wild salmon is our top priority and is in the best interest of future generations of Washingtonians."

The non-treaty recreational fishing alternatives include the following quotas for fisheries on the northern Oregon coast and all of the Washington coast:

Option 1: 58,600 chinook and 37,800 coho. This option includes early season fisheries, from June 18-30, for hatchery chinook in Washington's ocean waters (marine areas 1-4). This option also allows hatchery coho retention in all four marine areas during the traditional summer fishery.

Option 2: 30,000 chinook and 14,700 coho. This

option does not include early season fisheries for hatchery chinook, but provides summer chinook fisheries in all four marine areas. Hatchery coho fishing would be allowed only in Marine Area 1 (Ilwaco).

Option 3: No commercial or recreational salmon fisheries in

Washington's ocean waters.
