SEASIDE — Banks built a 12-0 lead through three innings, then finished with seven runs in the top of the fifth in a 19-1 win over Sea-

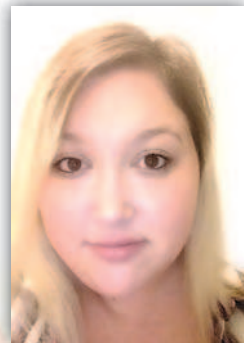
side Wednesday, in a Cowapa League baseball game at Broadway Field.
