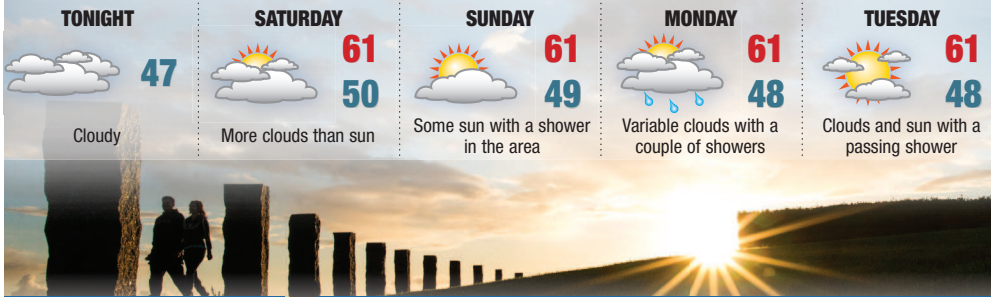
Learn more about Oregon's health insurance rate review process at a forum being presented Wednesday at Clatsop Community College.

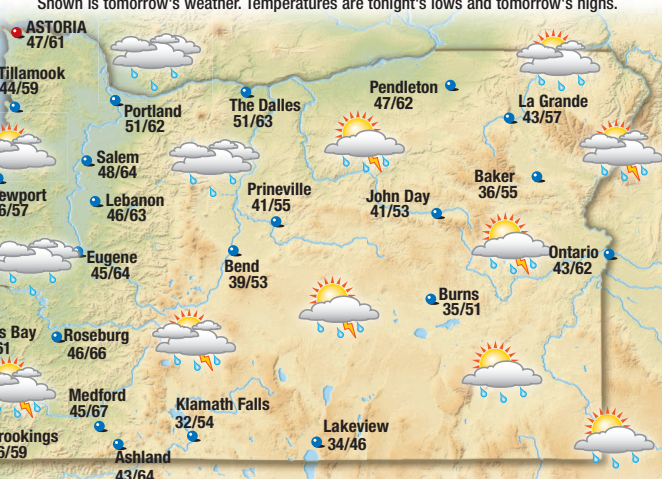

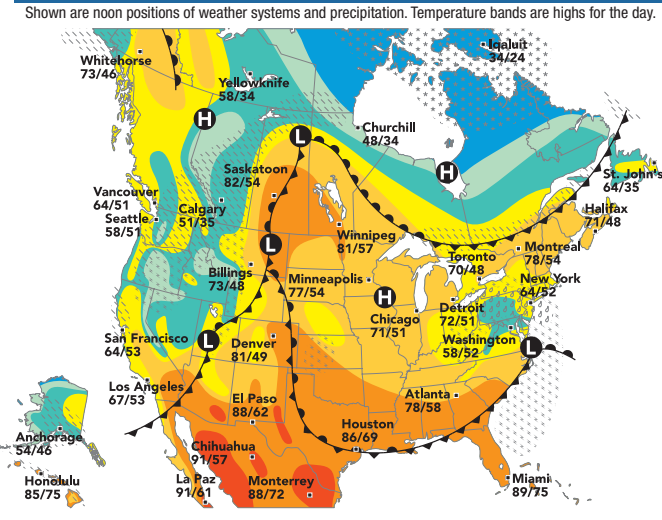
