Whatever your version of "I'm sorry," be it in the form of a hug or in words, is perfect. That's it. That's enough. It doesn't matter how the person died. However, if you have an anecdotal story about this person, please share it. We love to hear stories about our loved one. Send a text. If there is an online tribute to this person, sign it. Also, cards are wonderful. I don't know what is the statute of limitations on expressing condolences, but we are still receiving cards months after the event, and they are still comforting.

The family holds these things close. We are struggling to put our lives back together without this person in it. — Sad
