## Port: It plans to spend \$60,000 at Tongue Point

The stormwater system is designed to treat outfalls on Pier 3 and near Pier 2, where above-benchmark amounts of copper were found to be entering the Columbia River. But Knight said the system is designed to be expanded in the future as stormwater treatment requirements expand and cover more of the Port's land.

At Tongue Point, the Port plans to spend \$60,000 from operating funds to divert stormwater through a filter. Knight said a similar plan to have tenants help pay would not work at the site, because the Port can't definitively ascertain the sources of copper there.

Permit and Project Coordinator Robert Evert said a request for proposals on the stormwater projects have recently gone out, will be reviewed early next month and could be approved as soon as July by the Port Commission.

In other business: Construction starts in July on runway rehabilitation at the Astoria Regional Airport. Airport Manager Gary Kobes said the project will start with drainage work, followed by runway repaving, with the entire project to be completed by late September. At about \$5 million, most of it through the Federal Aviation Administra-

tion with a local match from a previous Connect Oregon grant, the project represents one-third of the Port's operating budget.

The Port Commission approved a \$700 check to Knappa High School for a new welding machine. The high school has been fabricating railings to try and keep sea lions off the docks at the East End Mooring Basin. Englund Marine & Industrial Supply will donate another \$700 to buy welding equipment.

Knight said the chances of success for the Port's \$1.5 million application to the state Department of Trans-

portation's Connect Oregon VI infrastructure grant program have drastically improved since he and state Sen. Betsy Johnson, D-Scappoose, stumbled for the project in Salem. The Port requested the money from the state to help match disaster funds the agency hopes to receive from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for repairs of

winter storm damage.

The Port Commission approved the creation of a capital improvement fund for future projects. Staff Accountant Will Isom said the Port's budget committee earmarked \$215,000 for the account to save for dredging and Pier 3 projects, with a plan to put another \$60,000 in by the end of the fiscal year.

## Ballot: Draft ordinance requires a business to confine objectionable odors

Beach municipal code prohibits licenses for businesses that are unlawful, illegal or prohibited by state or federal law. Since marijuana is not legal in federal law, the city cannot issue business licenses to marijuana shops. The draft ordinance has separate sections for medical and recreational marijuana, as state law currently does, although the two sections are nearly identical. The draft requires a criminal background check by police for all applicants and others with a financial interest in the marijuana facility, and that the building comply with applicable laws and regulations for buildings and zoning.

The draft also requires the business to confine objectionable odors with an air filtration and ventilation system, and prohibits the use of marijuana and tobacco products on the marijuana facility site.

A medical marijuana facility cannot operate within a residence or mixed-use property, residential areas of various densities, estuary, open space and RV park.

By state law, the facility cannot be within 1,000 feet of a public or private school.

to not worsen traffic problems, Councilor Mike Benefield said.

"The nature of that (marijuana) business is not people stopping and shopping," Benefield said. "We already have a parking issue in downtown."

Councilor Melissa Cadwallader agreed that marijuana shops should be excluded from downtown, "the heart of the commercial area."

Mayor Sam Steidel said he would restrict marijuana businesses from being downtown, and could see midtown and potentially Tolovana as possible locations.

Councilor George Vetter cautioned placing an additional "level of bureaucracy" on marijuana businesses.

"I'm not comfortable with us picking out a section of free enterprise and placing a bunch of rules and restrictions on that," he said, adding that marijuana activity will not be publicly seen.

Councilor Wendy Higgins said she might prefer marijuana retail downtown, rather than in a residential area.

"If it's going to be commercial, I would probably prefer it to be in the downtown area," she said.

### Downtown concerns

Although the draft restricted marijuana facilities in downtown and midtown limited commercial zones, leaving only the Tolovana Park limited commercial zone available, councilors had differing ideas about what locations to restrict.

Marijuana shops should be restricted from downtown to maintain the character and
