

Ferry: 'She's been gone a long time'

They had anticipated the ferry arriving as early as this afternoon, but inclement weather has so far thwarted those plans and forced Lint to remain at Port Townsend, Washington.

When the ferry does arrive, "hopefully, we can drum up enough people that want to come down and see the ferry for the first time after 50 years," Dulcye Taylor, vice chairwoman of The Astoria Ferry board, said.

Community asset

News of the ferry's imminent return comes after a yearlong effort to bring the Tourist No. 2 home.

In mid-2015, Robert "Jake" Jacob, majority owner of the Cannery Pier Hotel, learned that the 92-year-old ferry --- which had been rechristened "MV Kirkland" - was moored in Bremerton, Washington. He and Lint decided that the Tourist No. 2 belonged in its birthplace.

The project leaders originally expected to welcome it back last summer, but coordinating the haul-out and scheduling the inspections and repairs proved more complicated than they had predicted.

In the meantime, the group worked to raise funds and gather community support.

The nonprofit, which recently placed a \$15,000 deposit on the ferry, plans to buy the Tourist No. 2 from Lint on contract.

Andrea Perez, a board member, said the group is expanding to include more volunteers who will act as docents. In addition, they are putting together an online fundraising platform.

Eventually, they hope to convert the ferry into a community asset that, like the Astoria Riverfront Trolley, will offer rides to locals and visitors, and provide a venue for private parties.

"Who'd (have) thought that 90 years later the original wooden Ferry Boat would come back to town," Jacob wrote in a message. "It is an amazing opportunity for Astoria to bring it back!"

'Sweet old boat'

The three-deck, wooden-hull watercraft - which replaced the Tourist No. 1 is the last surviving Astoria ferry, one of several that operated on the river during the 20th century, until the Astoria Bridge rendered ferry service obsolete half a century ago.

Ron Stidham, an Olney resident who worked on the ferries, including Tourist No. 2, from 1956 to 1966, hopes to be there when it appears.

"I've seen just a few small photos of it, and I'm intrigued as to what they've done," he said.

He expects that seeing the ferry again will feel like reuniting with an long-lost friend.

"She's a sweet old boat, handled the best of any of them here," he said. "It's going to be something to see. She's been gone a long time."

Seahawks, coach Carroll agree to contract extension

RENTON, Wash. - The Seattle Seahawks and coach Pete Carroll have agreed on a contract extension, keeping the oldest head coach in the NFL locked up beyond the 2016 season.

Team owner Paul Allen tweeted confirmation of Carroll's deal on Tuesday.

The move with the 64-yearold Carroll came just two days after the team locked up gen-

der's current deals were set to expire after the 2016 season, but the tandem pairing that has brought the Seahawks unrivaled success in their franchise history will be teamed together for another few seasons.

Carroll is 60-36 in the regular season since becoming Seattle's head coach in 2010. He's taken the Seahawks to the playoffs in five of six seasons, including two Super Bowl appearances and the only title in franchise history.

Carroll's deal was first reported by ESPN and said the extension goes through the 2019 season.
