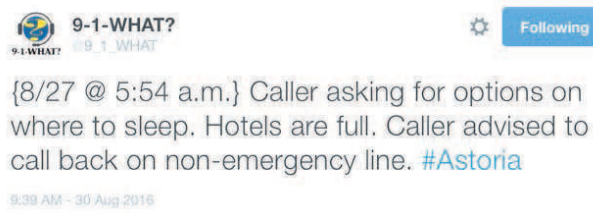
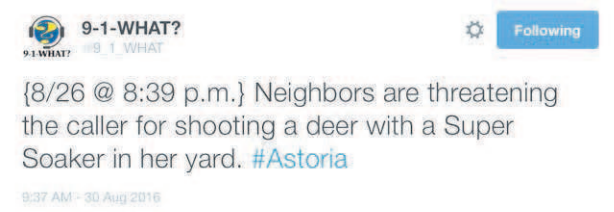
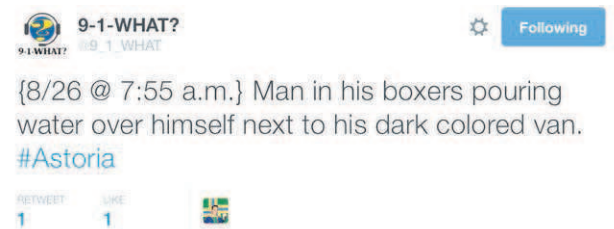
### No room at the inn
