Caruana wins Estacada Invite

ESTACADA — Astoria cross country runner Lucas Caruana is gearing up for a great post-season run, following another victory Wednesday. The senior was just a couple seconds off his 5,000-meter personal best, on a slick, rainy course in the Estacada XC Invite, held at McIver Park.

Caruana finished in 17 minutes, 1.40 seconds, well ahead of Estacada senior Tyler Kammeyer (17:17). Unfortunately, the Astoria boys did not score as well in the team standings, finishing fifth out of five teams. Estacada took first with 36 points, followed by Molalla, Madras and Gladstone. Astoria's next-highest finisher was sophomore Parker

Ivanhoff (22nd, 19:24). Astoria junior McKenzie Burnett also ran a very strong race, setting a new personal best, but was passed in the final 800 meters to finish second behind Estacada's Hannah Hart in

the girls' race. Hart finished in 21:00, to Burnett's 21:14. Kathy Perez placed 15th in 24:02 for the Lady Fishermen, who were third in the team standings behind Estacada and Molalla.

Pirates win the Wreck of the Iredale Race

WARRENTON — The Neah-Kah-Nie Pirates scored a pair of team victories Tuesday in the "Wreck Race," the annual cross country meet hosted by Warrenton. The third-annual event took place in Fort Stevens State Park, on the beach and on the paths and parking areas near the wreck of the Peter Iredale.

A 5,000-meter varsity race was held, along with a 3,000-meter race for middle school runners. Runners had to deal with 30-plus mph winds, with hail and heavy rains at times. Neah-Kah-Nie topped the team standings in the high school varsity race, as the

Pirates had 30 points on the girls' side, ahead of Rainier (47), Clatskanie (69) and Warrenton (81). Knappa also had runners taking part in the girls' race. Neah-Kah-Nie freshman Aspen Becker recorded the best time, finishing in 19 minutes, 25 seconds. She was followed by freshman teammate Karissa Hadermann in 19:28, with Knappa senior Devin Vandergriff a distant third in 21:23. Warrenton's top finisher was freshman Kaisa Liljenwall, seventh in 22:20. Warrior senior Taylor Owens was 13th (23:39). Six teams scored in the boys' race, with Neah-Kah-Nie picking up the victory with 55 points. Rainier (58) was sec-

ond, followed by Clatskanie (60), Warrenton (65), Knappa (124) and City Christian (162). Neah-Kah-Nie senior Colby Hixson finished first in 16:12, ahead of Warrenton senior Luke Liljenwall (16:53). Warrior teammate Alan Martinez was sixth in 17:31, just ahead of Knappa's Cody Hobbs (17:37). Astoria swept the middle school race. Astoria eighth-grader Sophie Long was the girls' winner in 11:20, helping the Vikings to 39 points in the team standings ahead of Broadway Middle School (58), Neah-Kah-Nie (60) and Warrenton (74). Astoria easily won the boys' race with 24 points, well ahead of Warrenton (54), Rainier (54)

and Neah-Kah-Nie (115). Astoria eighth-graders Cameron VanRaden (9:40) and Manuel Salinas (10:35) finished first and second, with teammate Damion Burgess fifth (10:59), ahead of Warrenton's Niko Boisvert (11:15).
