- 3360** - Air unit with a 4,500 psi compressor for SCBA air bottles

Hamlet Station (Hamlet Road)

- 3322** - Structural Fire engine with 1,000 gal./1,000 gpm pump
- 3332** - Water tender with 2,200 gallons of water
