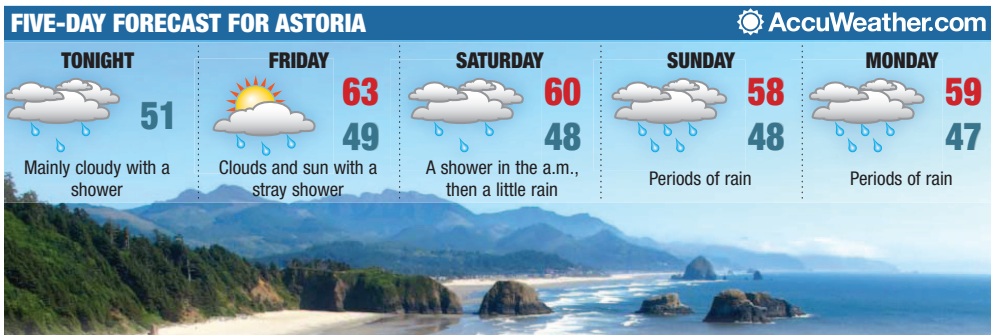

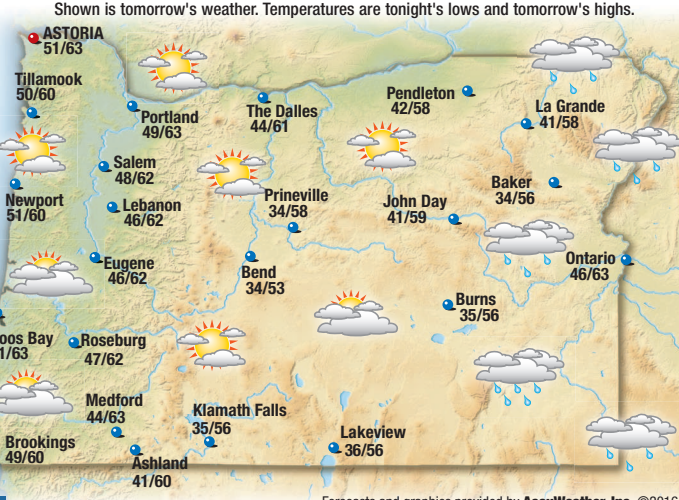

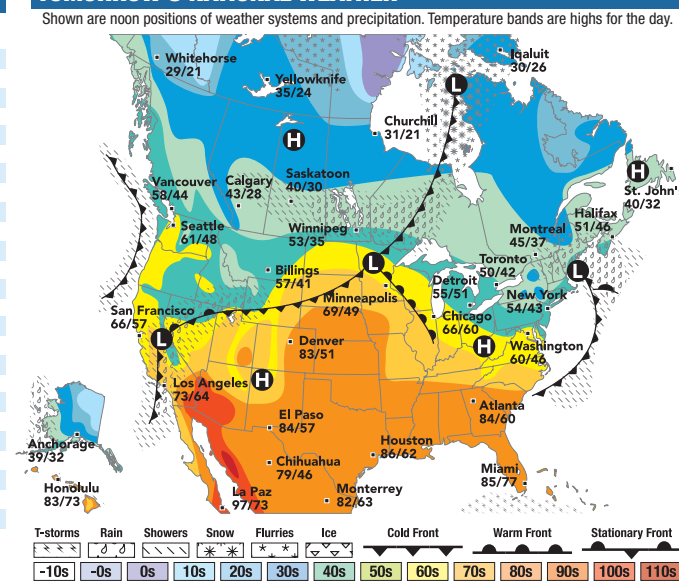

## Housing Authority board seeks applicants

## Safeway covered by potential corporate tax

PORTLAND — Safeway said that it is, in fact, subject to taxation under Measure 97 — a reversal of what the company said in a statement last week delivered through the measure's opponents.

"We had a misunderstanding," said Jill McGinnis, Oregon spokeswoman for Safeway and Albertsons. She said Albertsons

stores, which share a common owner with Safeway, are not subject to the tax. The Oregonian/OregonLive reported online Tuesday that Safeway and Albertsons were exempt from the tax, a consequence of the unusual way Measure 97 is organized. The initiative proposes a 2.5 percent tax on sales within Oregon over \$25 million, but exempts certain types of businesses from the tax.
