### **OIL CHANGES**

Regular oil changes aren't just required for a long-lasting engine. They can also help improve gas mileage, too. By keeping the friction in your engine down to a minimum, fresh oil can create a slight improvement in fuel economy.



### SPARK PLUGS

Old, dirty spark plugs can cause a 2-mpg drop in your car's gas mileage. Use the correct spark plugs for your car, and carefully check the plug gaps to ensure a clean spark and complete combustion in your engine, which saves on gas money.



#### **AIR FILTER**

Your engine needs to breathe cleanly to get the best performance and fuel economy. Dirty or clogged air filters can cause a drastic drop in mileage - up to 14 percent on older cars - so always make sure your air filter is clean to get the most out of every tank of gas.



### GAS CAP

Finally, your gasoline can disappear into thin air if your gas cap is loose, damaged or missing. Gasoline will evaporate if there's not a tight seal at the cap, so make sure you regularly check it for proper function and condition.
