

Beyonce is pregnant with twins

NEW YORK (AP) — Blue Ivy is about to become a big sister — twice. Beyonce and her husband, Jay Z, announced Wednesday on Instagram that the superstar singer is pregnant with twins. "We have been blessed two times over. We are incredibly grateful that our family will be growing by two," said a statement signed "The Carters," Jay Z's real last name. The news accompanied a photo of Beyonce showing a baby bump while wearing just a bra, underwear and a veil, in front of a backdrop of flowers. Their daughter, Blue Ivy, was born in 2012. Beyonce is the most nominated woman in Grammy Awards history. This year she leads all Grammy nominees with nine and is due to perform at the Grammy ceremony on Sunday, Feb. 12.

Peter Capaldi quits 'Doctor Who'

LONDON (AP) — Peter Capaldi, the latest incarnation of "Doctor Who," says he is quitting the lead role in the BBC science fiction series at the end of the year. Capaldi joined the show in 2013. He says "it's been cosmic" but "it's time to move on." The 58-year-old Scottish actor will star in a 12-episode series starting in April and make his exit in December. "Doctor Who," first broadcast in 1963, is one of BBC's most popular programs. Capaldi is the 12th actor to play the Doctor, an alien Time Lord who travels through space and time. The Doctor can regenerate into new bodies, and speculation has begun about Capaldi's replacement. Favorites include Ben Whishaw — Q in the 007 films — and actor Richard Ayode.

Grace Kelly's home will reopen

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Prince Albert of Monaco says the childhood home of his late mother, Princess Grace Kelly, will reopen to the public next year or earlier. Albert tells People magazine that the Philadelphia home he purchased last year for \$754,000 will house offices for the Princess Grace Foundation and a U.S. extension of Monaco's Princess Grace Irish Library. It will also be made available for public events once it is renovated. Albert says that since the home sits in a residential neighborhood, "it won't be exclusively a museum." Kelly accepted a marriage proposal from Prince Rainier III, in 1955. The home was built in 1935 by Kelly's father, John Kelly, a three-time Olympic gold medal-winning rower in the 1920s.
