

# Lawsuit: Fire, explosion are still under investigation by police

Oei could not immediately be reached for comment. Magley suffered burns to more than 20 percent of his body, spent a month at the Legacy Oregon Burn Center in Portland and has been undergoing outpatient rehabilitation and physical therapy. The suit claims Higher Level's production space violated multiple fire-protec-

tion and workplace-safety laws through the lack of an automatic sprinkler, fire and smoke alarms, liquefied petroleum gas detectors, adequate venting, an explosion suppression system, signed exits, suitable fire control devices, emergency lighting and a safety shower. Magley's lawyers issued written notices about the lawsuit to all the defendants last week.

The fire and explosion are still under investigation by the Astoria Police Department, the Oregon State Police and the Clatsop County District Attorney's Office. District Attorney Josh Marquis said he wants to contact the attorney for Magley and incorporate information from the case into the investigation.

**Many defendants**  
Oei and West leased the

production space at the corner of Industry and Portway streets from building owner Richard Delphia, who is being sued along with his companies Dick & John LLC, Dick's LTD, Dirick Properties, D&D Gas Inc. and Delphia Enterprises Inc. Subleasing an upstairs storefront from Oei and West was Sweet Relief Astoria, named as another defendant. Also named as defendants

were Under the Bridge Cigarettes in Astoria and UTB Investments, both companies run by regional cigarette and marijuana store financier John Harper. The suit claims Harper's companies helped finance the buildout of Higher Level Concentrates and sold the unodorized, and thus defective, gas used in the THC extraction process that built up and exploded upon ignition.

"Sweet Relief Astoria, the Harper Defendants and Delphia Defendants were aware that the Astoria Trading Defendants were using an unreasonably dangerous process for cannabis extraction," the suit says. "Plaintiff had no knowledge of the unreasonably dangerous condition and unreasonable risk of harm to which he was being subjected while he was present at the" building in October."

Between them are items that make sense — from the building's original furniture, to a stockpile of prints and paintings that the library used to loan out — and some surprises, including a pulpit and two pews, Samurai dolls and a small container of ash from Mount St. Helens. The City Council recently announced it will move forward with a proposal to renovate the nearly 50-year-old library building, using existing monies and whatever amount can be fundraised. The full cost and the design remain unknown. But one thing is clear: Before long, the hundreds of items in the basement will need to be sorted and, in some cases, assigned a new home.

**Artifacts aplenty**  
Library Director Jimmy Pearson said that walking through the basement feels like a stroll through the history of Astoria. His attention is always drawn to something new. A copy of Capt. George Flavel's father-in-law's will. A fishermen's ledger from the 19th century listing their names and catches. Copies of The Daily Astorian dating back to the 1870s. The 1907 government-issued printing of the U.S. presidents' official portraits, from George Washington through William McKinley, that once belonged to The Washington Post.

The oldest object Pearson believes he has discovered so far: the Slusher family's German Bible, printed in 1728 and brought to the U.S. in the 1880s. The volume is accompanied by a letter from the library to Mrs. Harley Slusher thanking her for the book and tracing its origins.

A veteran himself, Pearson personally paid to have the decoration framed, and to reframe a portrait of Salvon in uniform. Both now hang in the Flag Room, also known as the Veterans Memorial.

played, in the Columbia River Maritime Museum or the Clatsop County Historical Society's Heritage Museum.

Soon after Pearson took over in November, he found, in a basement corner, a Purple Heart that was awarded posthumously to Staff Sgt. Everett J. Salvon. Salvon graduated from Astoria High School in 1940, joined the Oregon National Guard, spent 26 months in combat overseas and was killed on Biak Island, Papua, in 1944 at age 20. Pearson located Salvon's grave in Greenwood Cemetery on Veteran's Day. The soldier's family has since died out.

**Purple Heart**  
The city has asked John Goodenberger, a local historian who often uses the library's resources for research, to help identify, inventory and, if possible, date the items. Pearson has also invited Astoria High School's senior leadership class to help organize them. "If we have to clear all that out as part of a library remodel, I'd rather know what is of value and what is not," City Manager Brett Estes said, "and if there are things that we can surplus, then let's do that as part of the remodel." The city may decide that some relics would be better kept, and more likely to be dis-

**The basement's future**  
But what will become of the basement itself? Estes and Pearson believe it probably won't be used as an active library space, such as a children's area, because the move would require additional staffing. However, a remodel that converts the basement into a community room has been loosely discussed. "We're not going to know anything until, I think, an architect becomes involved on a paid level to figure out what we can do within the constraints of the finances we already have, and what we can do if we raise more," Pearson said.
