

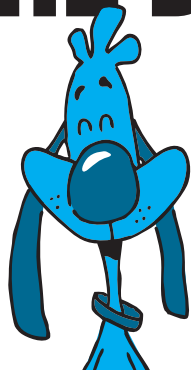

(But he needs YOUR help!)

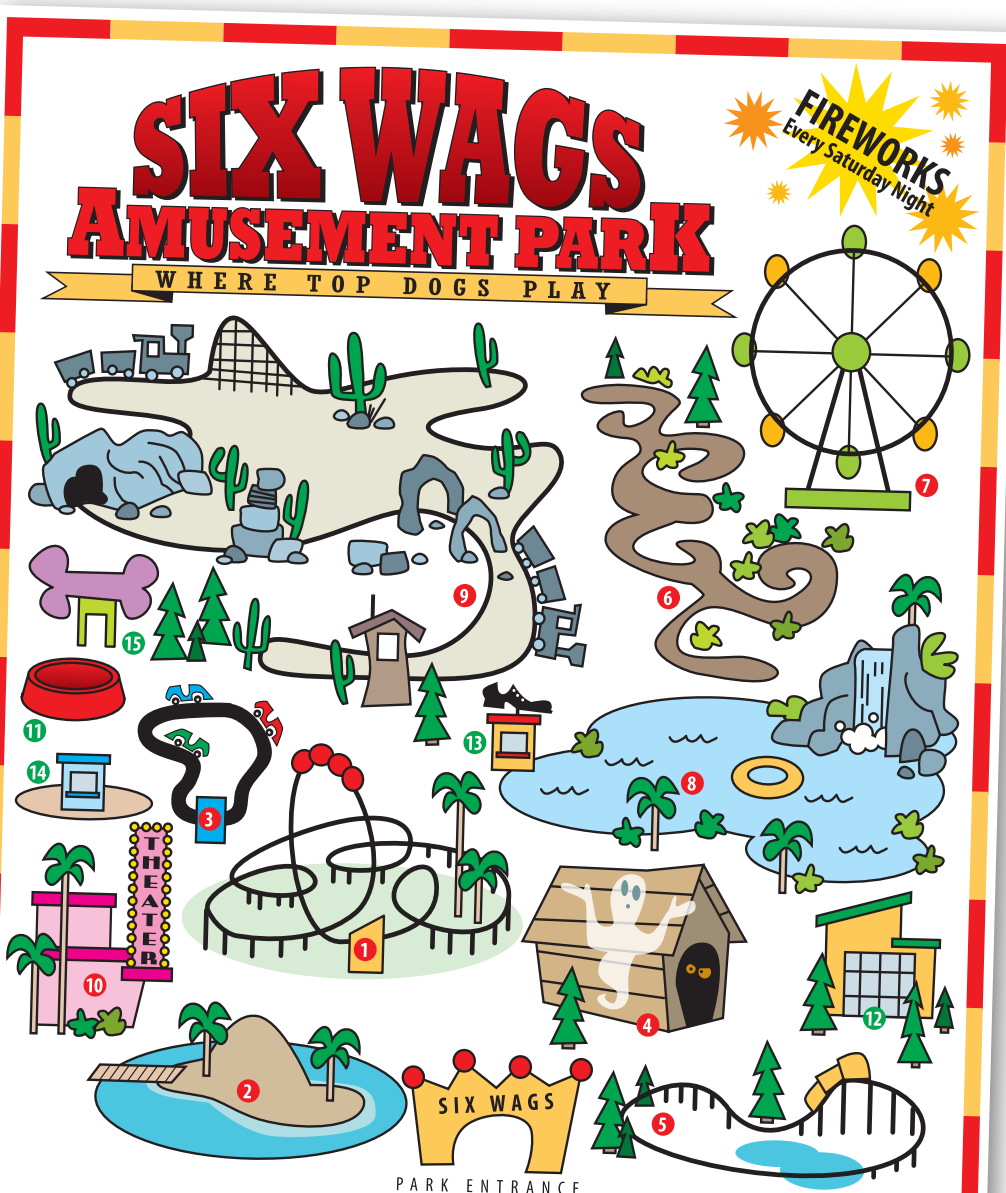
Fritter has exactly \$100 to spend. Will he ride all the rides? Will he choose snacks or souvenirs?

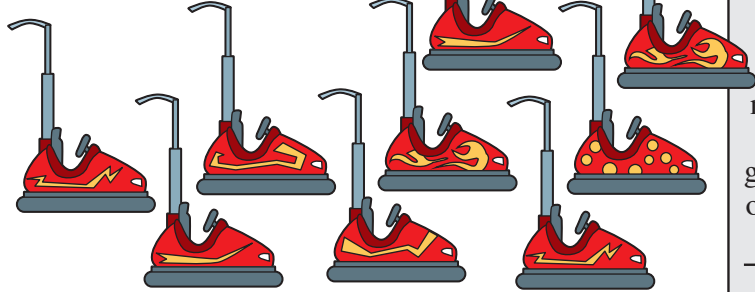

Find numbers to place on each chair of the Ferris wheel so that the numbers on two chairs across from each other and the number in the middle add up to 15.

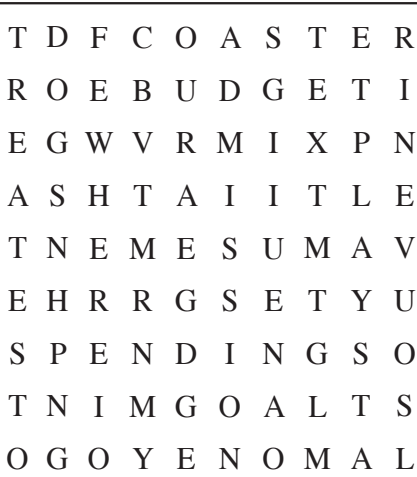


Standards Link: Math; students compute sums to 15 using three addends.

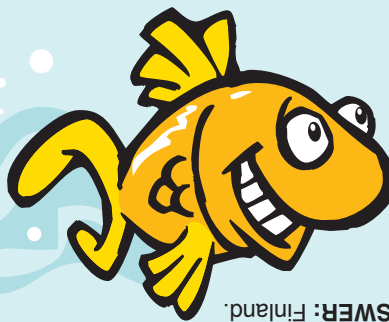
