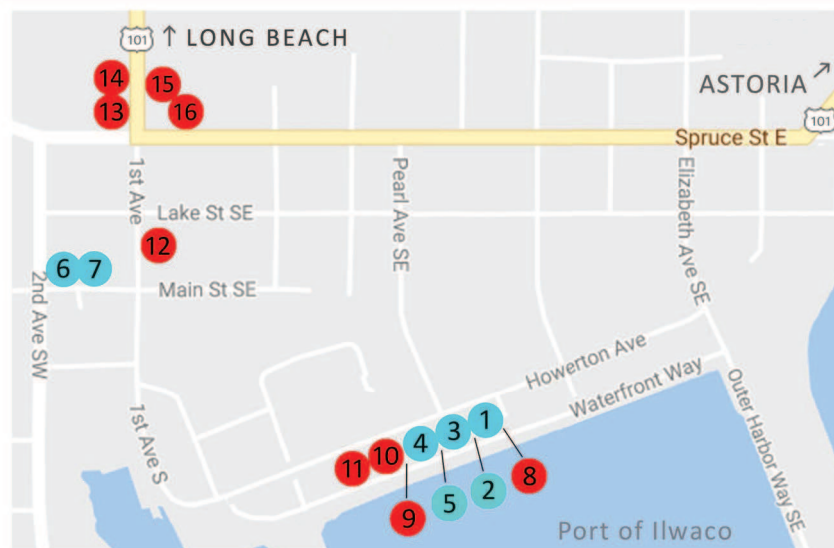
### 6. BILL ATWOOD/A. ESKELIN STUDIO 114 Main Street SW
