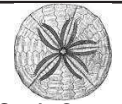

STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES AND SOURCES OF FINANCING
RESOURCES: The District is assuming steady local property tax collections and strong timber revenue. The District has a local option levy which will continue to assist with general operating resources. The voters passed a General Obligation (GO) Bond for a K-12 campus project. REQUIREMENTS: The District's budget represents an increase over actual 2016-2017. General Fund starting increases include: a 1.0 FTE licensed counselor; a 1.00 FTE HS position; 1.72 FTE in special needs assistants; and a .41 FTE regular educational assistant. Extra duty additions include a K-12 Stem Coordinator; a 6-8 Afterschool Coordinator; and two Strength and Conditioning Coaches. All new positions have been made for a Science curriculum adoption. General fund transfers will be allocated to ASPIRE, Food Service, Capital Projects and Capital Maintenance Reserve Funds. Vehicle replacement includes three buses. Contingency has been reduced to offset costs associated with the anticipated Charter School. Debt service has been allocated for the new GO bond payment and a new Capital GO Bond fund has been established to track revenues and expenditures.
