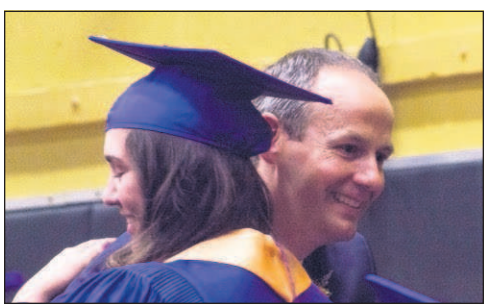

More than 120 seniors turned their tassels from right to left Saturday as they graduated from Astoria High School.



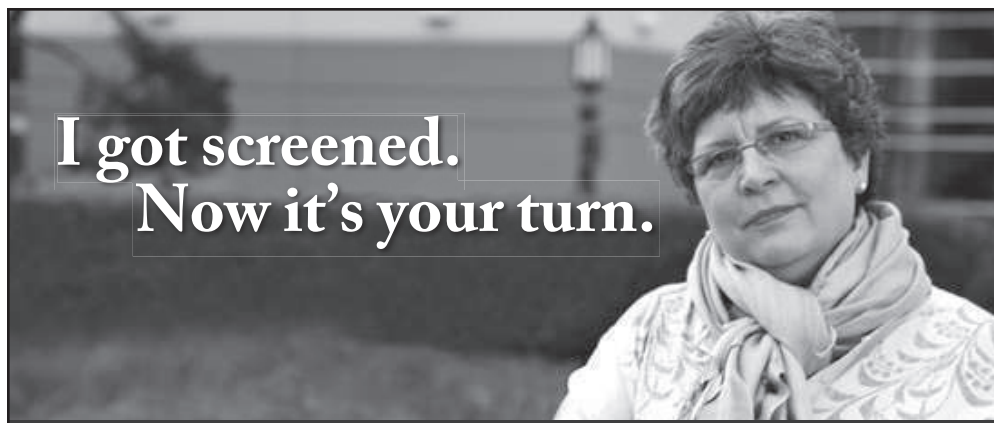
