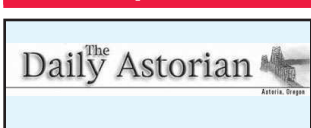

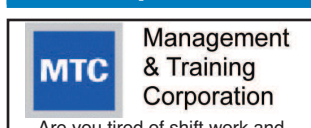

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Valid Oregon Driver's License, HS diploma or equivalent, pre-employment background check, physical and drug test.

UTILITY WORKER I REQUIREMENTS: Mandatory qualifications include graduation from high school or equivalent, and possession of valid driver's license with the ability to obtain a commercial driver's license within 6 months of employment. Some experience in water, sewer, stormwater utility work and parks maintenance is desirable.

POSITION: Under the supervision of the Operations Manager, a Utility Worker I operates heavy construction equipment, power equipment and commercial vehicles.
