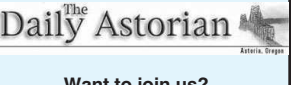

Requirements: No experience or education required. Tools provided by employer. No resume required. The employer will assist in helping locate optional housing which is paid by the employee.

Job Duties: The position requires standing or walking and assists the Floral Designer in assembling Christmas Wreaths, Arrangements and Garlands by initially selecting material, fir boughs, that will be used to construct the above items. They may be positioned at a table with the Floral Designer or with other helpers/packers. Clippers, banders and staplers are the only tools required and are provided by the company. Helpers/packers receive on the job training in the proper techniques of handling the material. Helpers/packers are to provide support, materials and supplies for the Floral Designers. The Helper/packer prepares materials and products for use in those items listed above, including measuring, weighing and counting.
