# Housing: Some 500 housing units are in process in Warrenton

A request for proposals for a consultant could go out by the end of October, with the goal of having someone on board by the end of the year or early next year. The county also plans to form a steering committee with representatives from the cities.

"I don't know where we'll end up dollar-wise on this, but I'm pretty confident the \$100,000 is more than enough to get this done," Moore said.

Moore acknowledged that most housing development will take place within city limits, not necessarily on county land, but he said it seems appropriate for the county government to spearhead this effort.

"Is the county part of the solution? Yeah, we are part of the solution."

#### Why?

For many city officials, the first question they asked when presented with the county's proposal was along the lines of: "I understand where you're coming from, but why?"

Many of Clatsop County's cities already have a sense of where they fall on the housing spectrum; they may have even completed extensive housing studies on their own. Many have or are considering implementing construction excise taxes to help fuel new housing development. Astoria recently completed a registry to track vacant houses and identify where housing could be reopened or created.

At an Astoria City Council meeting earlier this month, City Councilor Zetty Nemlowill wanted to know what Moore

envisioned as the end product. "The result," she said. "Other than just another study that sits at City Hall."

Every city has one of those, said city officials across the county as they discussed the county's proposal. They have the study that, as Warrenton Mayor Henry Balensifer said, "sits on the shelf and nothing really comes of it." Or, said

Warrenton City Commissioner Tom Dyer, the studies that follow other studies and are "the same thing called something different."

In many ways Astoria and Warrenton are at completely opposite ends of the housing issue.

Kevin Cronin, Astoria's community development director, and Astoria Mayor Arline LaMear say their city will likely look at existing buildings, houses that need some rehabilitation — or "adaptive reuse" — to make them available for renters or buyers, rather than new construction.

"I hope that we can get more new construction projects like what (developer) Joe Barnes is doing over above the (Astoria Recreation Center)," Cronin said, pointing to a 32-unit apartment complex in the works on Astoria's South Slope. "But for the most part we're a built-out community."

In Warrenton, some 500 housing units are in process this year alone — either under construction or still in the permit and design review stages — and there is still more land available.

### Bird's-eye view

But Warrenton and Astoria both decided to participate in the countywide study. City officials said no city has taken the county's full housing market and related issues into account. That lack of a bird'seye view was what convinced

many of the cities to sign on.

Even though Cannon
Beach completed its own
housing study last year, the
City Council unanimously
agreed to participate in the
county study.

"All cities are in the same boat right now when it comes to affordable housing," said Jason Schermerhorn, the interim city manager for Cannon Beach. "It's not just a problem in this county, it's statewide. Being involved will help us have a broader idea on how to handle it."

"I look at the housing issue as not just a city of Astoria issue," Astoria City Manager Brett Estes said. "It's really a county issue and what can we all collectively be doing."

After all, he said, there's "leakage" between the different cities, meaning people who work in one city might be trying to live in another, or might be forced to live outside the city they work in because of the lack of housing. Balensifer also made a similar point as the Warrenton City Commission discussed the agreement.

"For me it's, 'OK, we can look at Astoria but, really, what's the need for the whole area?" Estes said. "And what's the availability for the whole area?"

# Thompson: Results of internal investigation were revealed in executive session

fellow commissioners, and County Manager Moore that has bubbled under the surface for several months.

Commissioner Scott Lee, the board's chairman, learned of the incident soon after it happened, though he did not disclose how. Lee then called an executive session in late July with other board members and Portland-based labor attorney Heather Martin. At the private session, the board decided to pursue an investigation and hire Jill Goldsmith of Workplace Solutions Northwest, a Portland mediation service, to conduct the probe.

Goldsmith interviewed the county employee who had allegedly been touched by Thompson, a witness to the incident, and a county employee who has a personal relationship with Thompson and is familiar with the commissioner's demeanor and concerns about the county manager. Thompson declined

to be interviewed but submitted her account through an attorney.

The results of the internal investigation were revealed to commissioners during an executive session Wednesday night.

"Several staff have raised issues about county government with me," Thompson said in an email to The Daily Astorian. "They said they

feared retaliation if they went public. I now understand their fears of retaliation."

But Lee insists the internal investigation was a human-resources matter meant to ensure that county staff are protected from commissioners, who supervise the county manager and staff.

"It's outrageous that she would accuse me of making this issue politically motivated," Lee said. "I have been following the advice of county counsel."

## Official role

The internal investigation found that Thompson was acting in her role as commissioner during the June 27 incident after a Red Cross meeting at Fort Clatsop in Lewis and Clark National Historical Park

cal Park.

After the Red Cross meeting, Thompson approached the county employee and expressed frustration with Moore. She also allegedly said that she "was the only commissioner on the board

who worked."

Thompson, according to the report, at one point became agitated about Moore, stepped toward the county employee and asked, "Do you know what he did?" As the county employee reflexively placed her hands up, Thompson allegedly placed her hands on the employee's hands or, according to the witness, upper arms near the shoulders. The county employee then took two to three steps back as Thompson vociferously repeated her question.

After untangling herself, the county employee asked Thompson what she was talking about. Thompson then allegedly expressed her belief that Moore had intentionally scheduled a meeting in May so that she would not be able to attend. The county employee described Thompson as upset and agitated during the conversation.

In the account Thompson provided through an attorney, the commissioner said she has no memory of physically pushing anyone backward. 'She is the first to admit she is sometimes loud — a character trait she attributes to her passion for the people of Clatsop County, to her blue-collar roots, and to her hearing loss. She is outwardly demonstrative. She sometimes talks with her hands or touches people during conversations (for example, she may place a supportive hand on someone's shoulder or she might touch someone's arm while making

### 'Appropriate decorum'

According to board rules, commissioners must commit themselves to "ethical, businesslike, and lawful conduct, including proper use of authority and appropriate decorum when acting as board members." The internal investigation concluded Thompson violated this policy.

violated this policy.

Lee pointed to an incident in 2014 when he castigated former County Commissioner Dirk Rohne, now a

Rohne allegedly complained about staff and former County Manager Scott Somers to Portland-based labor attorney Akin Blitz.

Port of Astoria commissioner.

"This is not the first time I've called out a commissioner for failing to understand how to do his or her job, in my opinion, and getting out of their lane with staff," Lee said. "It's a very big problem and it's been something that I take seriously."

David Kramer, Thompson's Salem-based attorney, questioned whether the board has the authority to investigate an independently elected official since that power is not specifically outlined in the county charter. He said the board's rules apply to conduct at board meetings, "but nothing you allege arguably relates to a board 'meeting."

Kramer called the internal investigation "likely politically motivated, and it undercuts the political independence of elected public officials."
