Getting competitive

Infinity has about 100 students, split almost evenly between boys and girls and mostly between the ages of 3 and 9. Competition is governed by USA Gymnastics, which has established 10 skill levels from rookie to elite.

"We're recreational, so we're not going by the competition levels, but we are learning the skills," Taylor said. "And that is one of our goals, to become competitive."

One of Infinity's assistant coaches, Astoria track star Darian Hageman, has reached level nine in gymnastics, slightly below the proficiency needed to try out for the Olympic team. Trying to follow in her footsteps is 11-year-old Madilyn Ericson, one of Taylor's top students.

Ericson met Taylor at the gymnastics unit in Seaside. After seeing a video of a 3-year-

old Olympic gymnast, Ericson went home and started teaching herself.

"I just watched tutorial videos on YouTube," Ericson said. "It's really cool. I do much better in PE."

Her mother, Gina Ericson, said her daughter now practices up to three hours a night.

Beyond any competition,

Taylor sees gymnastics as a confidence-builder, well-suited for the North Coast.

"I hope this is a place where kids can come and be dry and get exercise, because it's just so rainy here, and there's not a lot you can do outside," she said. "And we don't have enough stuff around here, activities for kids indoors."

"He would always meet me first thing in the morning when I came in to open," Jones recalled. "He was almost a fixture around here." Miles worked in the concrete business, Jones said, and walked or took buses most of the time.

"He was always smiling," Jones said. "He was always in a good mood. He was just a great guy to be around."

Jones let out a long sigh. "We are going to miss him around here."

Outside McDonald's, the bus shelter is gone, shattered by the impact of the crash.

Only a pole with a timetable marks its location. Flowers are carefully placed along the grass in memoriam.

Corrissa Barnett, 38, the alleged driver of the SUV, has been charged with manslaughter and other felonies and misdemeanor drunken driving.

After hearing a highly intoxicated person involved in the disturbance was driving, police attempted to stop a 1999 Dodge Durango allegedly driven by Barnett. The Durango, moving at a high rate of speed with the headlights off, then hit the police car before speeding away.

Soon after, as the SUV was headed northbound on U.S. Highway 101, the car jumped a sidewalk outside of McDonald's restaurant, struck a concrete light pole and slammed into a bus stop shelter occupied by two men. Robert Miles, 42, of Hammond — died, while the other man — Abdirisak Mohamed,

41, of Longview, Washington — was critically injured.

Officers allegedly found Barnett hiding behind bushes. She was arrested and recorded a blood alcohol content of 0.26 percent five hours after the incident.

Barnett is scheduled to appear in court for an early resolution conference in November.
