

Saturday Artisans' Fair supports Clatsop Emergency Food Bank

A Fine Artisans' Fair will be held at the First Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall in Astoria Saturday, to raise money to support the Clatsop Emergency Food Bank.

Fair organizers say many local people rely on the food bank during the winter months. The money raised from booth rentals will go to the food bank to help during

the difficult holiday season, organizers say.

The fair will feature local artists and craftsmen, selling everything from fine-art paintings to jewelry, ceramic and glass crafts and food.

The event begins at 10 a.m. and runs until 4 p.m. Admission is free. The First Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall is located on the corner of 11th Street and Harrison Avenue.
