## Memorial: More than \$40,000 secured, exceeding original goal

donations and gained political support from local officials such as state Sen. Betsy Johnson, D-Scappoose.

In total, they secured more than \$40,000, exceeding the original goal of \$26,530.

"We didn't have any opposition, basically," Bert Little said.

Some of the money also

came from purchases of 4-inch by 8-inch concrete memorial bricks that will be placed in the area below the statue. The bricks, still available for purchase for up to \$60, are intended to individually honor local veterans by name.

The statue is the latest, but likely not the final, addition to an increasingly robust display near a busy downtown intersection. The grassy

area next to the Post Office features several flagpoles and some other small tributes. A second bench may be added to the area sometime in the future, said Bert Little, who also sits on the Warrenton Parks Advisory Board. "We'd like people to be able to come here during the day and eat their lunch," he said. "This is basically going to be a monument park."

## Bear spotted in Hammond for second straight year

Police had posted video of a bear a year ago

WARRENTON — Residents who beared witness to an unusually large, black animal Tuesday were not hallucinating.

Police have received at least three calls since a bear was reported to be digging through trash in a dumpster at the Hammond Marina Tuesday morning. Residents also claimed their garbage had been disturbed.

At this point, police believe just one bear is roaming. Since Tuesday was garbage day in Hammond, the animal may have been more active than usual, Police Chief Mathew Workman said.

A rarity on the Oregon side of the Columbia River, bears were also spotted in Warrenton and Hammond last October. Warrenton police posted a video exactly one year ago Tuesday of an officer chasing a small black bear off Skipanon

Drive in a car. Workman had only heard of one bear sighting in his eight years as chief before that report.

"I don't know if it's the same bear looking to hibernate in the area or what, but it's ironic," Workman said.

Workman advised residents not to approach bears, remove as many food scents as possi-

ble from outside homes and secure garbage cans. While it is natural for bears to roam at night, residents should call police if they are creating a dangerous situation or if the animals are spotted during the day.

"If you keep your distance, you should be fine," Workman said.
