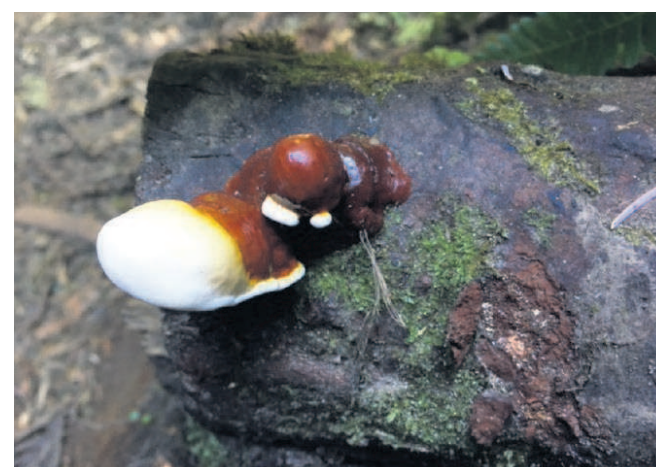
## Master medicinal mushrooms at Sou'wester
