A national AAUW project, Tech Trek is a weeklong summer camp designed for girls entering the eighth grade to learn about math and science. The purpose of the camp is to encourage girls to enter a career in Science, Technol-

ogy, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), so the participants collect data from field trips, conduct scientific experiments and interact with women in STEM careers.
