Willis divides her time among her roles as mother, poet and advocate for democracy.

Willis' first book, "Blood

Sisters of the Republic," was released by Press 53 in 2012. Her second book of poems, "A Long Late Pledge," won the Dorothy Brunsman Poetry Prize and was released by Bear Star Press in 2017.

Willis has published poems and essays in a wide variety of journals, including New England Review, Oregon Humanities, Poetry Northwest, The Rumpus, Zócalo Public Square and ZYZZYVA. She is a faculty member in poetry at the Attic Institute in Portland.
