An elector may file a petition for review of this ballot title in Clatsop County Circuit Court no later than May 10, 2018 pursuant to ORS 255.155. **Caption:** Imposes county tax on the retail sale of marijuana items **Question:** Shall Clatsop County impose a three percent (3%) tax on the retail sale of marijuana items in unincorporated Clatsop County. **Summary:** Under state law, a county governing body may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters imposing up to a three percent tax or fee on the retail sale of marijuana items in unincorporated areas of the county by a state licensed marijuana retailer. If this measure is adopted, it would approve Clatsop County Ordinance No. 2018-04, which imposes a three percent (3%) tax on the retail sale of marijuana items in the unincorporated area of the county by a state licensed marijuana retailer. The marijuana retailer will collect the tax at the point of sale and remit the tax collected to the County. The ordinance also provides for the collection, administration, and enforcement of the tax.
