fine artists will have original works on display in all media as well.

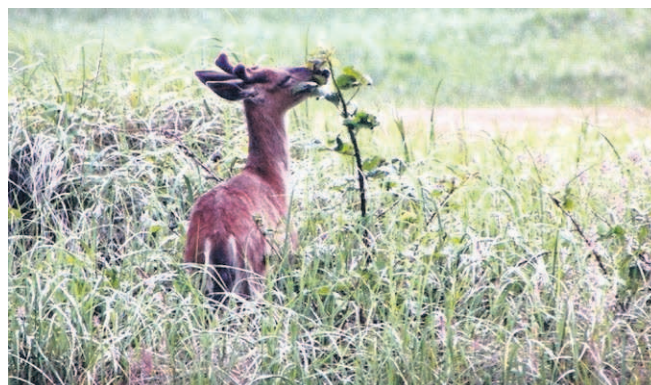
