artist is Janet Nelson Hutchings displaying her show titled "A Little Bit of Everything." She will be honored with a reception 2 to 5 p.m. The gallery is located one block south of Pacific Way in the "Little Red

Schoolhouse."

Hutchings, a fabric artist, is originally from San Diego, Calif., where she was a member of Spanish Village Art Center. She creates quilted landscapes and flowers,

animal portraits and mixed-media pieces using fabric, thread, paint, ink, wood and just about anything else that enhances the image.

When commercially printed fabrics no longer suited her needs, Hutchings learned to paint and dye fabrics, adapting mark-making techniques typically used on paper. She also prints her own landscape and animal photographs on several types of fabric, then quilts these images and embellishes them to bring out the details and give her work a three-dimensional look.

Her work can be found at Tempo Gallery in Astoria and Trail's End Art Gallery in Gearhart and occasionally on her website, wcartisans.com.
