ASTORIA — The Harbor's 15th annual Soup Bowl takes place 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. Saturday, June 2, at The Loft at the Red Building in Astoria.

Our focus this year is on the opening of our new Confidential Emergency Shelter, which is also happening in June.

Did you know that, because of many complex barriers, including lack of safe housing, it takes a survivor an average of seven attempts to leave an abusive relationship? Or that 50 to 75 percent of domestic violence homicides occur when a survivor is fleeing?

This is why emergency shelter is an extremely vital service and

one we are thrilled to provide.

Our shelter program is about more than just a place to sleep. It's about carefully planning with survivors so they can safely and successfully leave an abusive relationship. It's about providing support and community that respects the identities, cultures and goals of survivors so they can leave the shelter with new power and control over their lives.

It's about supporting survivors to be in their element — rebuilding self-love, self-worth and self-trust.
