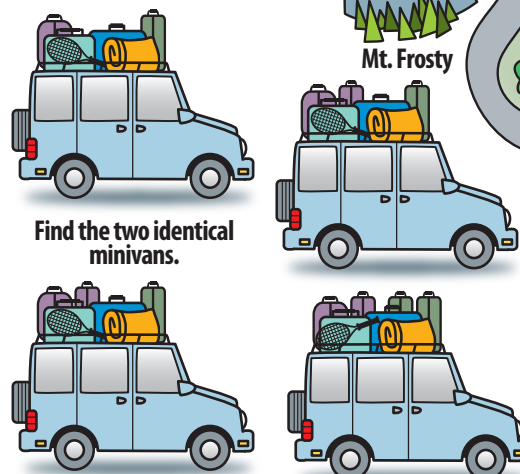

Find the two identical minivans.

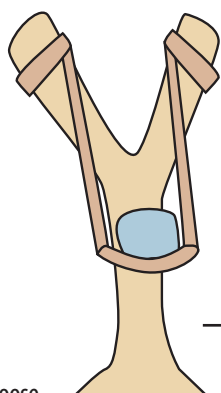
## North American Road Trip

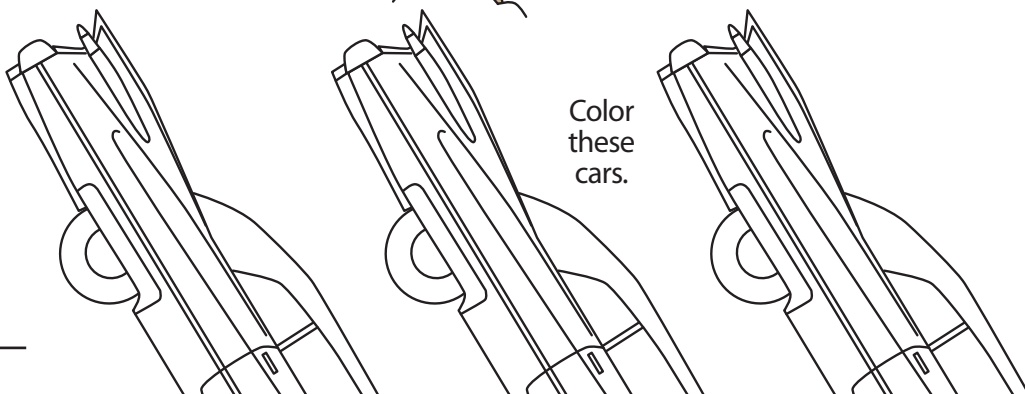

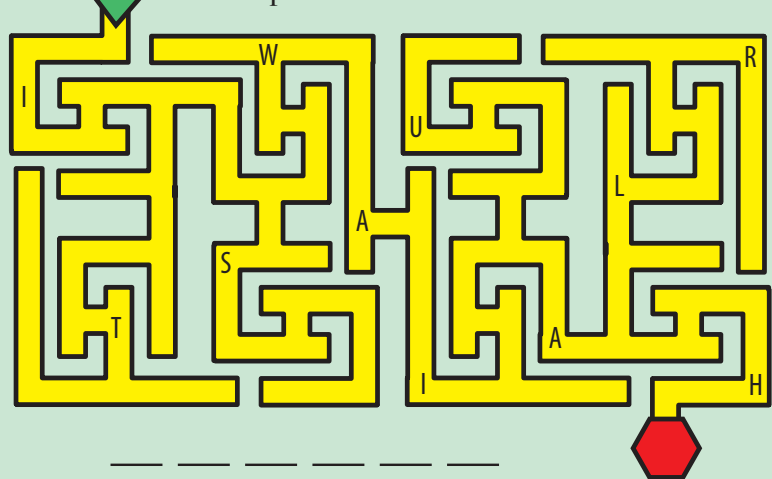

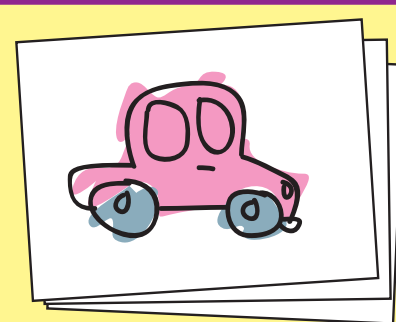
