PECIAL DISTRICTS: In addition to the general country government budget, Clatsop Country manages the independent budget of four special districts. Each district is governed by the Board of Country Commissioners. Both the 4+1 & Extension and Rural Law Enforcement Districts include advisory committees of local districts. The Westport Sewer Service District is the only district that has payment of a loan received in 2006 in the total amount of \$112.250.

Road District No. 1: In 1988, voters approved a road district tax base. These monies are transferred to the Road Department to support an increased level of maintenance and construction. This budget anticipates received of \$1.98 in property tax revenue and \$1.98 in interference.
