### Amusing Food

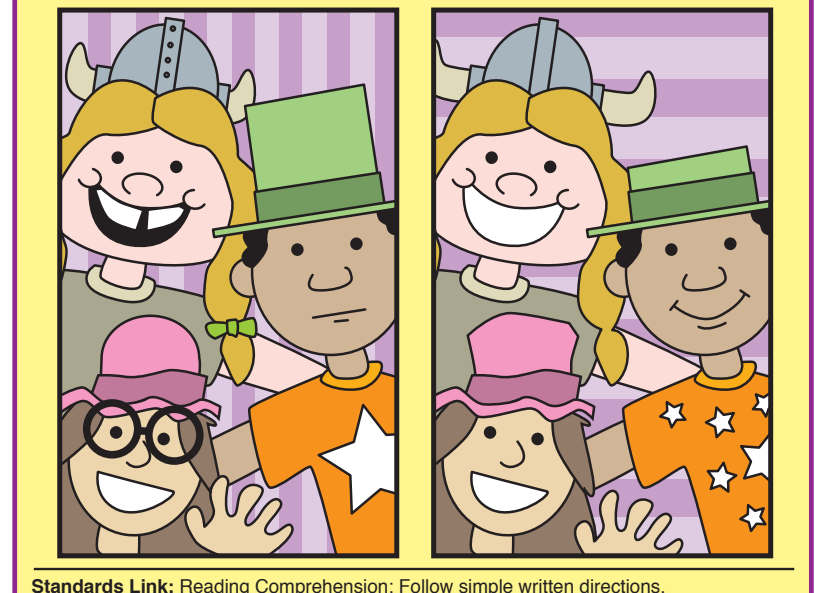
