

Sentence: Johns has faced numerous charges in county since 1992

Johns and his girlfriend had been living on-and-off with his uncle — Ronald Boudreau, 66 — at a home on U.S. Highway 101 Business prior to the March 2017 incident. Boudreau and his nephew would regularly drink together, often leading Johns to assault his uncle, Deputy District Attorney Ron Brown said. Boudreau

never reported the attacks. “He never wanted his nephew to get arrested, so charges were never filed,” Brown said. One night, Johns repeatedly punched, kicked and stomped on Boudreau. When Johns’ girlfriend tried to intervene, he allegedly assaulted her before she fled. Johns then dragged Boudreau out to a trailer and

left him inside before leaving. When Johns checked the trailer the next day, Boudreau was dead. An autopsy revealed he had died from blunt-force trauma, including a crushed chest, nine broken ribs and injuries to his face and scalp. “It would be an extremely painful and slow way to die,” Brown said. Authorities found the body later that day, and Johns was

arrested in Portland two days later. “The fight that we had was out of stupidity, alcohol and frickin’ human jealousy,” Johns said. Johns has faced numerous felony and misdemeanor charges in Clatsop County since 1992, including convictions for menacing, theft, criminal mischief, burglary, driving under the influence of intoxicants and assault.

Circuit Court Judge Dawn McIntosh said she hopes Johns can better himself, but she is not optimistic. “This is an extremely sad case,” McIntosh said before referencing the previous times Johns had attacked Boudreau. “I wonder what he was thinking in those last moments?” Johns apologized to members of his family who were

in court for the hearing. He said some of them now look at him with contempt, but said he probably loved his uncle “more than any of them.” As part of the plea agreement, Johns will be required to pay \$1,792 for his uncle’s funeral expenses. “I miss you, Ronny,” Johns said. “You’re in that band in the sky and I will be with you soon.”

labs at Seattle’s Woodland Park Zoo, the children of wild female silverspots collected from Mount Hebo in the Siuslaw National Forest in Tillamook County.

“Numbers are dictated year to year by (the Fish and Wildlife Service) but it is highly likely we will continue to operate at or near capacity over the next several seasons at least,” said Travis Koons, who oversees the Oregon Zoo’s butterfly conservation program. “We will continue to release high numbers of larvae at the various sites.”

The silverspot caterpillars were placed on early blue violets in three different areas on Saddle Mountain. Over the next few weeks and throughout the summer, Patterson and others will check different survey points, counting any adults they see. Though Patterson is confident this first reintroduction will find some degree of success, he said, “At the same, it’s not a one-time quick fix kind of deal. This is just the first of probably quite a few efforts to go up there and release more caterpillars.”

“We have worked with them since the inception of this project with the understanding that we are going to do everything reasonable to keep their operation going, but that there was going to be some disruption,” City Engineer Nathan Crater said.

Some visitors will inevitably be disappointed if the trolley is dark. “They want that trolley experience,” said Bob Miller, a volunteer conductor. “It’s a 43,000-pound ambassador for the city. We may be the only thing they’re going to see of the city.”

Co-op: ‘We’re not against the co-op, just change the location’

They ask that the co-op use 23rd Street as the main access to the store instead of Steam-whistle Way, a narrow road to the north of the property that gives residents access to their garages. At past meetings, co-op representatives said they would widen Steam-whistle Way and change signage to minimize the impact on neighbors.

“I think the community at large thinks we’re against the

co-op,” said Storey, the president of the Mill Pond Village Owners Association. She feels like their point has not been heard: “We’re not against the co-op, just change the location of the building.” Some members of city boards who reviewed the co-op’s application echoed the residents’ concerns about traffic flow through the neighborhood. But Matt Stanley, the co-op’s general manager, believes the co-op has done

its best to address those fears. The co-op wants to move because it has outgrown its store on Exchange Street downtown. “We think it works,” Stanley said of the expansion plan, and added, “We have 4,000 plus household owners that co-own our community business. This is a local venture that is really poised and ready to go to make this happen and a lot of people are frustrated that it’s delayed. We have made accommodations for

the people impacted there. We understand their concerns.” “We tried to accommodate their requests as much as we could,” said Don Vallaster, a Portland architect who owns the property where the store wants to build and is working with the co-op to develop the site. If the property owners are hiring attorneys, he said, “I guess we’ll have to, too.” “It’s not our desire to go that route, but it looks like that’s where it’s going.”
